FROM THE CEO'S DESK - 01 MAY 2020



RAMADAN: On behalf of the Councillors and staff, I would like to take this opportunity to send our best wishes to the many people in our community of the Islamic faith who are in the holy month of Ramadan. As per the Shire's usual practice in the interests of the health and well-being of our staff, the outside crew work from 6am to 12noon each day during Ramadan.

RAMADAN: Bagi pihak Konsel dan pekerjanya, saya ingin mengambil kesempatan ini untuk menyampaikan ucapan kepada semua orang dalam masyarakat yang beragama Islam yang berada di bulan suci Ramadan. FINANCIAL RELIEF: The Shire recognises the serious impact the COVID-19 pandemic is having on the community as a whole and acknowledges our role in offering financial relief. Council has endorsed a COVID-19 Support Package comprising a mix of funding and in-kind support designed to mitigate some of the impacts that will be felt across the community in the short to medium term. The package includes the following:

Shire rates INCREASE freeze -The standard annual increase in rates is usually 3%. A 3% saving per

rateable property e.g. The average rateable value of general developed (residential) is \$17,166. This would result in an average rate amount of \$1871 and an average saving of \$56 per property.

Reduce the rate in the dollar for holiday accommodation to the same as residential. The Differential rate in the dollar for Holiday Accommodation is .1617 as opposed to the residential rate of .1090. This reduction will result in a 48.34% saving per effected ratepayer with an average saving of \$991 per property, noting that this will vary based on rateable value of each property.

Shire waste collection charge INCREASE freeze.

The short-term employment of a grants officer to help the community access government assistance offerings.

Expediting planned capital projects in the coming months to ensure employment and business opportunities for the local community.

Advocating for the reduction of registration fees for businesses such as car hire providers who currently pay registration at a higher business use rate.

Advocating for a freeze on increases to water, sewerage and electricity rates for the 2020/2021 financial year.

Further measures in relation to commercial leases and Kampong rentals will be considered by Council, acting in its capacity as Trustee, at the May Council meeting.

BANTUAN KEUANGAN: Konsel menyedari kesan serius yang ditimbulkan oleh pandemik COVID-19 kepada masyarakat secara keseluruhan dan mengakui tugas kami dalam menawarkan bantuan keuangan. Konsel telah mengesahkan Pakej Sokongan COVID-19 yang terdiri daripada gabungan bantuan dan sokongan dalam bentuk yang

dirancang untuk mengurangkan beberapa kesan yang akan dirasakan di seluruh masyarakat dalam jangka pendek hingga sederhana. Pakej ini termasuk yang berikut:

Penyetopan BERTAMBAHAN Rates Konsel - Peningkatan rate tahunan biasanya 3%. Penjimatan 3% bagi setiap harta tanah yang dinilai. Contohnya nilai pembangunan (kediaman) ialah \$17,166. Ini akan menghasilkan jumlah rate rata-rata \$1871 dan penjimatan rata-rata \$56 setiap harta tanah.

Kurangkan rate dalam dolar untuk tempat tinggal percutian sama dengan kediaman. Perbezaan rate dalam dolar untuk Tempat Tinggal Percutian adalah .1617 berbanding dengan rate kediaman sebanyak .1090. Pengurangan ini akan menghasilkan penjimatan 48.34% untuk setiap pembayaran dengan penjimatan rata-rata \$991 setiap harta tanah, dengan memperhatikan bahawa ini akan berbeza-beza berdasarkan nilai yang dapat dinilai dari setiap harta tanah.

PERTAMBAHAN bayaran sampah Konsel diberentikan.

Pengambilan pekerja masa pendek untuk membantu masyarakat mengakses tawaran bantuan kerajaan.

Mempercepatkan projek modal yang dirancang dalam beberapa bulan mendatang untuk memastikan peluang pekerjaan dan perniagaan bagi masyarakat tempatan.

Menyokong pengurangan bayaran pendaftaran untuk perniagaan seperti penyedia kereta sewa yang pada masa ini membayar pendaftaran pada rate penggunaan perniagaan yang lebih tinggi.

Menyokong pemberentian kenaikan rate air, pembuangan kotoran dan elektrik untuk tahun keuangan 2020/2021.

Langkah-Langkah selanjutnya berkaitan dengan penyewaan komersial dan penyewaan Kampong akan dipertimbangkan oleh Konsel, yang bertindak sebagai Pemegang Amanah pada mitingan Mei.

CORPORATE BUSINESS PLAN REVIEW: Councillors and staff have commenced a desktop review of the Corporate Business Plan (CBP) to ensure the initiatives and strategies flagged for 2020/21 are still relevant and a priority for the community. This review is important as the CBP provides the basis for the budget. Community members are invited to submit their comments on the CBP to the Shire by Monday 18 May for Council to consider. The CBP is available on the Shire

website <https://shire.cc/en/your-council/council-documents.html> or contact Ibrahim Macrae, Governance Coordinator on 9162 6649/governance@cocos.wa.gov.au to have a copy delivered to you. It should be noted that this is a minor desktop review to inform the budget, as a major review of the Community Strategic Plan (which informs the CBP) is scheduled for the second half of 2020 and at which time we will implement more thorough community engagement process.

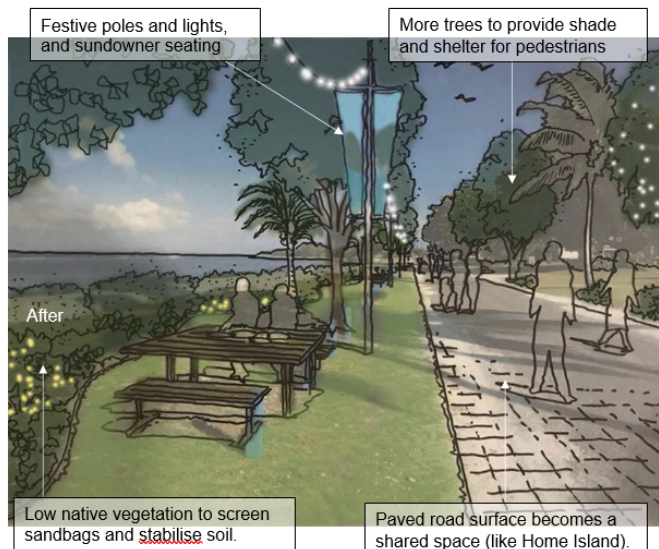

Council resolved at its May 2019 ordinary meeting to enter into a Lease Agreement with Zephyr Kite Tours for part Lot 100 West Island – South End Precinct for a period of 5 years with 5 year option.

This portion of land has been valued at \$1,600/annum and the Lessee will be required to pay this amount as well as annual CPI increases and the assessed annual Council Rates set from year to year.

Rumah Baru Public Bike Rack

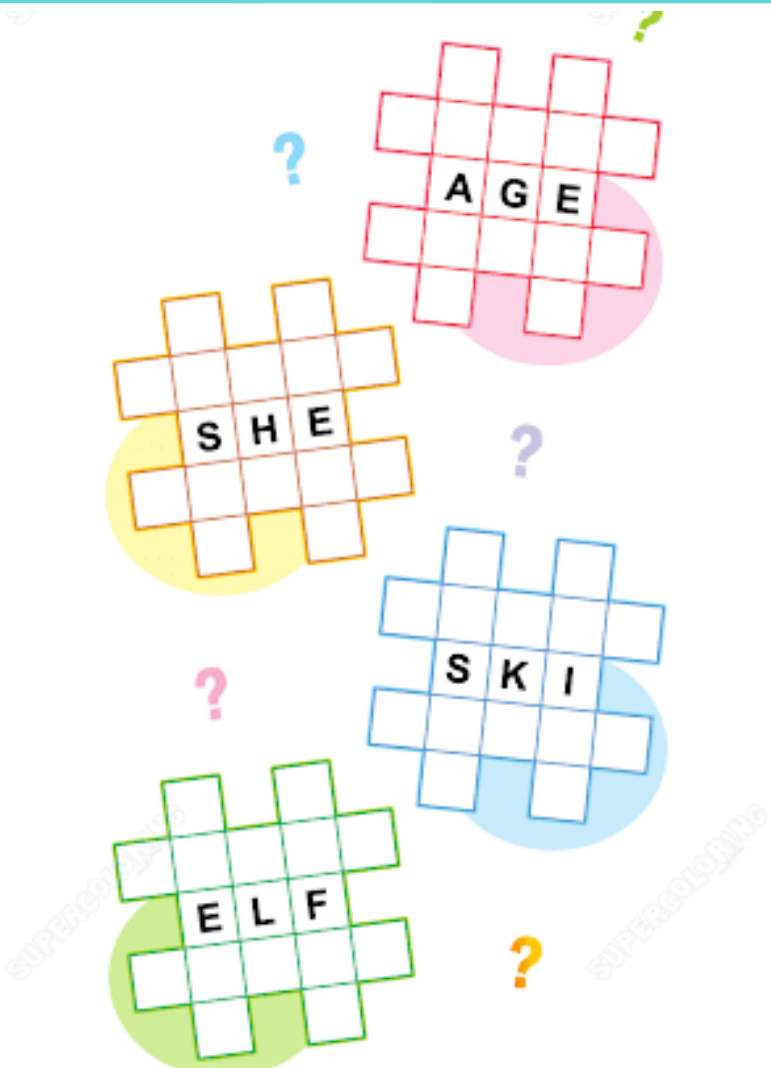

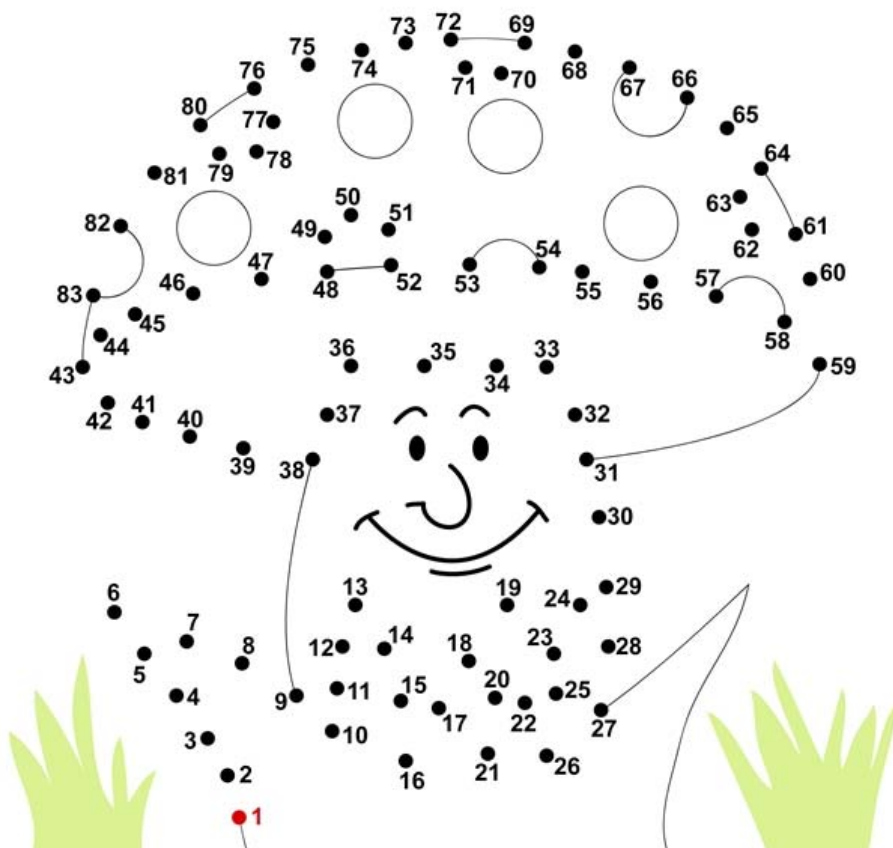
