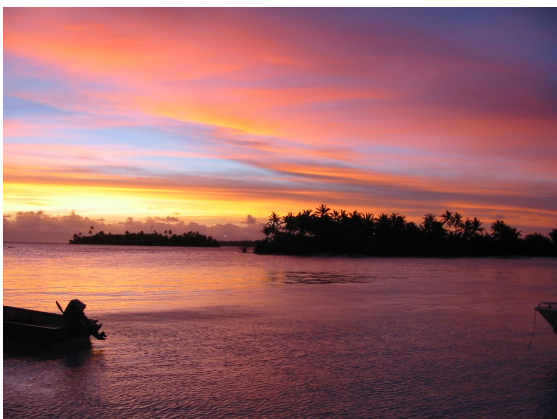

DIRECTION ISLAND RESORT PROPOSAL: After almost 18 months of discussions, robust community engagement and careful consideration by Council (acting in their capacity of Trustee of the 1984 Land Trust) has approved the lease of a portion of Direction Island to Cocos Bonesia Resorts (CBR) for the purpose of building a luxury eco-resort. The lease terms and every aspect of the proposed development are carefully explained in the Business Case which is on the Shire website for any member of the community to review. It should be noted that, given the current situation, we have provided a 9-month window within which CBR must execute the lease. Once the lease is executed, CBR will have a busy time gathering the many items of due diligence requested by Council for the lease to continue.

PERMOHONAN RESORT PULU TIKUS: Selepas hampir 18 bulan perbincangan, penglibatan masyarakat yang teguh dan pertimbangan yang teliti oleh Konsel (bertindak dalam kapasiti mereka Pemegang Amanah 1984 Land Trust) telah meluluskan sewa sebahagian Pulu Tikus ke Cocos Boronia Resorts (CBR) untuk tujuan membina sebuah eco-resort. Masa penyewaan dan setiap aspek pembangunan yang dicadangkan dijelaskan dengan teliti dalam Kes Perniagaan yang terdapat di laman web Shire untuk mana-mana ahli masyarakat untuk memeriksa semula. Perlu diingat bahawa, memandangkan keadaan masa sekarang, kami telah menyediakan masa 9 bulan di mana CBR mesti melaksanakan penyewaan. Sebaik sahaja sewaan dimulakan, CBR akan mempunyai masa yang sibuk untuk mengumpulkan banyak perkara yang wajar oleh Konsel untuk penyewaan diteruskan.

MACAO PAPER WASPS: With the EWP on Home Island, the team (Wedding and Neale) have been able to make a great deal of progress in treating wasp nests, especially those located higher up in trees. Since 17 March they have treated over 350 nests on Home Island, despite a few days of interruption due to the rain. Thank you to members of the public for helping us to find nests – please keep those reports coming. If you see a nest on Home Island, please let the team know taking note of as much precise information on the location as possible. Neale said he wishes fish were as easy to find.

We acknowledge the Commonwealth for funding this program and for the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development for their advice and support.

MACAO PAPER WASPS: Dengan adanya EWP di Kampong, pekerja (Pak Mik dan Neale) telah dapat membuat banyak kemajuan dalam merawat tarangan wasp, terutama yang terletak tinggi di atas pokok. Sejak 17 March, mereka telah merawat lebih dari 350 sarang di Kampong, walaupun terdapat gangguan beberapa hari akibat hujan. Terima kasih kepada masyarakat kerana membantu kami mencari sarang - sila pastikan laporan terus datang. Sekiranya anda melihat sarang di Kampong, sila beritahu mereka informasi tempat yang tepat. Neale berkata dia berharap ikan adalah semudah ini untuk dicari.

Kami menghargai Commonwealth untuk membiayai program ini dan untuk Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development untuk nasihat dan sokongan mereka.

An exciting opportunity exists for a suitably skilled and experienced person to join the Shire team in delivering an invaluable service by bringing much needed grant funding into the community.

The Grants Officer will be responsible for identifying suitable grants for local businesses and organisations from the various funding streams currently available to stimulate the economy and provide financial relief to those who need it.

To be successful in this position the person will need to be familiar with the Cocos business context, have experience in navigating the grant funding environment, particularly at the Commonwealth and/or State level and be able to assist in developing high quality and competitive funding applications.

This is a time-critical role so, self-management, focus and the ability to work within very tight timeframes is essential. The remuneration of the position will be as a Level 5 of the Local Government Industry Award 2019 which is currently \$36.09/hour, inclusive of district allowance and 25% casual loading.

Hi Booklovers,

To be able to continue to use the library resources whilst the libraries are closed, the Shire has arranged for library staff to deliver books, magazines and DVDs that we have available at the library or that you need to return to the library.

In addition to the hard copies of books we hold in the library it is possible to take advantage of a vast library of e-resources such as e-books and e-magazines. Some people have access to these already through e-book systems such as Libby by Overdrive and Borrowbox. For library users who are not familiar with how to download the necessary App and set up Libby or Borrowbox on their phone, tablet or computer, I am very happy to assist if needed.

If you are confident you can download Libby or Borrowbox to your device without assistance, I will still need to advise you of your **barcode number and pin**, as being a small community, we don't need to issue library cards.

What is Libby? **Libby** is a free app where you can borrow e-books and digital audiobooks from your public library. You can stream books with Wi-Fi or mobile data, or download them for offline use and read anytime, anywhere. All you need to get started is a library card.

Bunbury Library has produced several easy to follow documents on how to download e-books through Libby and Borrowbox and e-magazines through rbdigital. I can email these documents to those interested or you can search for Bunbury library and/or type the following links in to your browser to access them yourself:

Untuk dapat terus menggunakan sumber perpustakaan sementara perpustakaan ditutup, Shire telah mengaturkan pekerja perpustakaan untuk menyampaikan buku, majalah dan DVD yang kami ada di perpustakaan atau yang anda perlukan untuk di kembalikan ke perpustakaan.

Sebagai tambahan kepada salinan buku yang kami simpan di perpustakaan, ada kemungkinan untuk memanfaatkan perpustakaan luas e-resources seperti e-books dan e-magazines. Sesetengah orang mempunyai akses kepada sistem e-book seperti Libby oleh Overdrive dan Borrowbox. Bagi pengguna perpustakaan yang tidak biasa dengan cara download App yang diperlukan dan Libby atau Borrowbox pada telefon, tablet atau komputer mereka, saya sangat gembira untuk membantu jika diperlukan.

Jika anda yakin anda boleh download Libby atau Borrowbox ke alat anda tanpa bantuan, saya masih perlu menasihati anda tentang nombor kod dan pin anda, sebagai sebuah komuniti kecil, kami tidak perlu mengeluarkan kad perpustakaan.

Apa itu Libby? Libby adalah app percuma di mana anda boleh meminjam e-books dan buku audio dari perpustakaan anda. Anda boleh menyusun buku dengan Wi-Fi atau data mobile, atau download untuk kegunaan tanpa internet dan membaca bila-bila masa, di mana sahaja. Apa yang anda perlukan untuk memulakan adalah kad perpustakaan.

Dealing with Police I – general police powers and being arrested

These are short articles about legal issues that may interest [you](#). They are not legal advice. You should always get individual legal advice for your situation.

This is the first article about dealing with police. We will deal with general police powers and the power to arrest in this article. In the next article we will deal with questioning and records of interview by police. In the third article we will deal with the search powers of police.

General powers of police

The police have general powers to keep the peace, prevent crime and protect people and property. In order to do this, they have more powers than ordinary people. These powers include to arrest and detain people (keep them from leaving), do searches of people and property, get information, seize items and get identifying information by DNA, photographs and fingerprints.

What is being under arrest?

Police have the power to arrest a person. An arrest is the process of taking a person into police custody. Police are allowed to do this to keep the peace, prevent crime and protect people and property.

Police can arrest you if they have an arrest warrant, which is a written authority from a court or justice of the peace.

Police (and ordinary citizens) can arrest you without a warrant:

- if they reasonably suspect you have committed (have done) or are committing (are doing) an offence that carries imprisonment as a possible penalty (this is called an "arrestable offence")
- if you are doing or about to do something that involves violence or makes someone fear violence
- to stop you breaching the peace
- to stop you committing an offence.

Police can also arrest you for "serious offences". These are:

- if you are failing to comply with an order made about an out of control gathering.
- have committed or are committing or will commit (will do) an offence of threats of family violence or serious acts of family violence
- you have breached (broken), or are breaching, or are going to breach a family violence restraining order, violence restraining order or police order or
- an offence that has a penalty of 5 years or more imprisonment.

Police can also arrest you if you have committed, are committing, or are going to commit, any offence and they can show:

- you will keep doing the offence, repeat the offence or commit another offence
- you are putting yourself or someone else or property in danger
- you are likely to interfere with a witness, or evidence or a police investigation,
- or
- there is no other proper way to find out your identity.

The police may decide to charge an arrested person with a criminal offence. If you are arrested, you have certain rights. These are to:

- be told that you are under arrest
- seek medical treatment if you need it
- be allowed to contact a friend or relative (unless that may allow an accomplice (a helper in the offence) to escape police, or it puts someone in danger, or it allows evidence to be destroyed or hidden)
- have an interpreter if you cannot comfortably speak English with the police, and
- some degree of privacy from the mass media.

If you are arrested as a suspect for an offence (someone who the police think may have committed the offence), you have these rights in addition to the ones above. They are to:

- be told what offence you are being arrested for and what other offences the police suspect you may have committed
- have a reasonable opportunity to contact a lawyer, and
- be “cautioned” and told your rights if the police interview you (we will deal with this later).

Police are allowed to use reasonable force in arresting you. You should submit peacefully to the arrest even if you think you have done nothing wrong.

If you resist, or assault the police, or abuse them, for example, you may be charged with obstructing a public officer, or assaulting a public officer or disorderly conduct. You should not interfere with anyone else being arrested, because you may be charged with obstructing a public officer.

You should not try to escape from being arrested, because you may be charged with escaping lawful custody.

If the force the police use in arresting you is unreasonable, they are committing an assault.

Once you are arrested, police can detain you for a reasonable amount of time to:

- investigate an offence
- interview you
- search you and your property or
- decide whether or not to charge you.

Berurusan dengan Polis I - kuasa polis dan kalau ditangkap

Ini adalah berita ringkas mengenai isu-isu undang-undang yang mungkin menarik minat [anda](#). Ini bukan nasihat undang-undang. Anda harus selalu mendapatkan nasihat undang-undang masing-masing untuk keadaan anda.

Ini adalah berita pertama mengenai berurusan dengan polis. Kami akan menangani kuasa polis dan kuasa untuk menangkap dalam artikel ini. Dalam artikel seterusnya kami akan menangani pertanyaan dan rekod interview oleh polis. Dalam artikel ketiga kami akan berurusan dengan kekuasaan pemeriksaan polis.

Kekuasaan Kebiasaan Polis

Polis mempunyai kuasa untuk pertahankan keamanan, mencegah kejahatan dan menjaga orang dan hak milik. Untuk melakukan ini, mereka mempunyai kuasa lebih dari orang biasa. Kuasa ini termasuk menangkap dan menahan orang (menjaga seseorang daripada melarikan diri), menjalankan pemeriksaan orang dan hak milik, ambil maklumat, amek barang-barang dan mengambil informasi melalui DNA, gambaran dan citakan jari tangan.

Apa itu erti di tangkap?

Polis ada kuasa untuk menangkap seseorang. Menangkap adalah proses menahan seseorang dalam tahanan polis. Polis di benarkan melakukan ini untuk menjaga keamanan, mencegah kejahatan dan menjaga orang dan hak milik.

Polis boleh menangkap anda kalau mereka ada surat penangkapan, yang biasanya surat berkuasa dari makamah atau pengamanan pengadilan.

Polis (dan rakyat biasa) boleh menangkap anda tanpa surat pemerintah:

- kalau mereka mencurigai yang anda sudah melakukan (telah buat) atau melakukan kesalahan yang akan membawa hukuman penjara (“ini di panggil kesalahan yang boleh ditangkap”)
- kalau anda melakukan atau akan melakukan sesuatu yang melibatkan kekerasan atau membuat orang takut kekerasan
- menghentikan anda melanggar keamanan
- menghentikan anda membuat kesalahan.

Polis boleh juga menangkap anda kerana "kesalahan serius". Ini adalah:

- jika anda gagal mengikut perintah yang di perintahkan berkenaan berkumpulan yang tidak boleh di kawal.
- telah melakukan atau sedang melakukan atau akan melakukan ancaman kekerasan keluarga atau kekerasan keluarga yang serius
- anda telah melanggar, atau sedang melanggar, atau akan melanggar perintah untuk menahan kekerasan keluarga, perintah untuk menahan kekerasan atau perintah polis atau
- pelanggaran yang ada hukuman 5 tahun penjara atau lebih.

Polis boleh juga menangkap anda kalau anda telah melakukan, sedang melakukan, atau akan melakukan, apa saja kesalahan dan boleh menunjukkan yang:

- anda akan selalu melakukan kesalahan, mengulangi kesalahan atau melakukan kesalahan lagi
- anda meletakkan diri anda seseorang atau hak milik dalam bahaya
- anda kemungkinan mengganggu saksi, atau keterangan atau penyiasatan polis, [atau](#)
- tidak ada cara lain untuk mencari identity anda.

Polis boleh [menentukan untuk](#) dakwa orang yang di tahan dengan kesalahan jenayah. Kalau anda di tangkap anda ada hak tertentu. Ini adalah untuk:

- di kasitau yang kamu di tangkap
- mencari rawatan perubatan kalau perlu
- di benarkan untuk menghubungi kawan atau sedara (kecuali yang membolehkan orang yang di tangkap (pembantu dalam kesalahan) untuk melarikan diri dari polis, atau meletakkan orang lain dalam bahaya, atau membenarkan bukti dimusnahkan atau tersembunyi)
- ada jurubahasa kalau anda tidak rasa selesa bicara orang putih dengan polis, dan
- beberapa tahap privasi dari media.

Kalau anda di tangkap sebagai orang yang dicurigai untuk kesalahan (seseorang yang polis fikir telah melakukan kesalahan), anda mempunyai hak ini dengan tambahan yang di atas. Mereka harus:

- Di beritahu kesalahan apa yang membuat mereka di tangkap dan kesalahan apa lagi yang polis curigai mereka sudah lakukan
- Ada kesempatan yang pantas untuk menghubungi lawyer, dan
- Berhati-hati dan di bacakan hak mereka bila polis interview mereka (kami akan menghadapinya kemudian)

Polis dibenarkan menggunakan kuasa yang pantas dalam menangkap anda. Anda harus menyerah dengan tenang kepada penangkapannya itu walaupun anda fikir anda tidak melakukan kesalahan.

Kalau anda melawan, atau memaki polis, atau kasarkan mereka, contohnya, anda boleh di dakwa dengan menghalang opisa umum, atau menyerang opisa umum atau kelakuan yang tidak senonoh. Anda tidak sepatutnya masok campor dengan sesiapa yang sedang di tangkap, sebab anda mungkin di denda dengan menghalang opisa umum.

Anda tidak seharusnya mencoba untuk melarikan diri dari di tangkap, sebab anda boleh di denda dengan melepaskan jagaan yang sah.

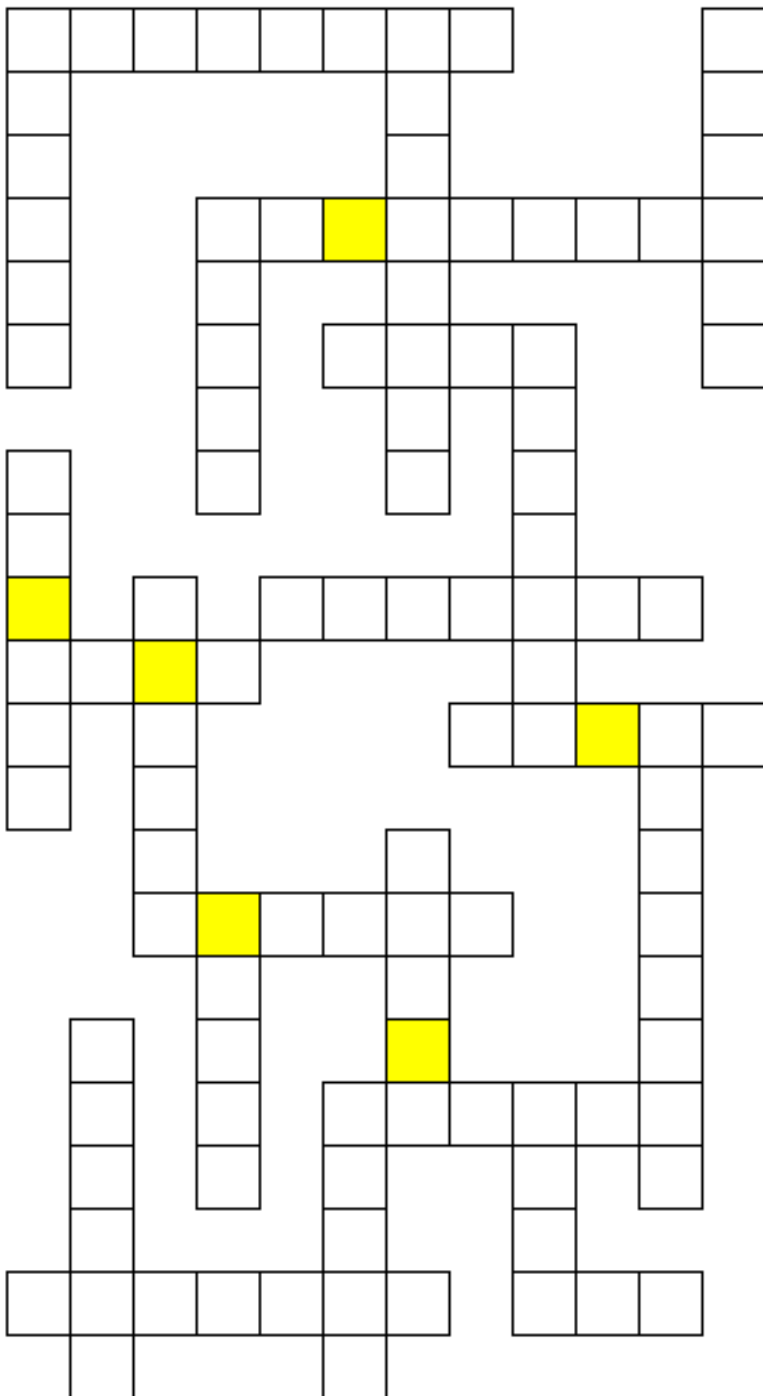
Jikalau kekerasan yang polis gunakan untuk menangkap anda keterlaluan, mereka melakukan serangan.

Bila anda sudah di tangkap, polis boleh menahan anda untuk masa yang patut untuk:

- siasat kesalahan
- interview anda
- meriksa anda dan hak milik anda atau
- pertimbangkan untuk mendenda anda atau tidak.

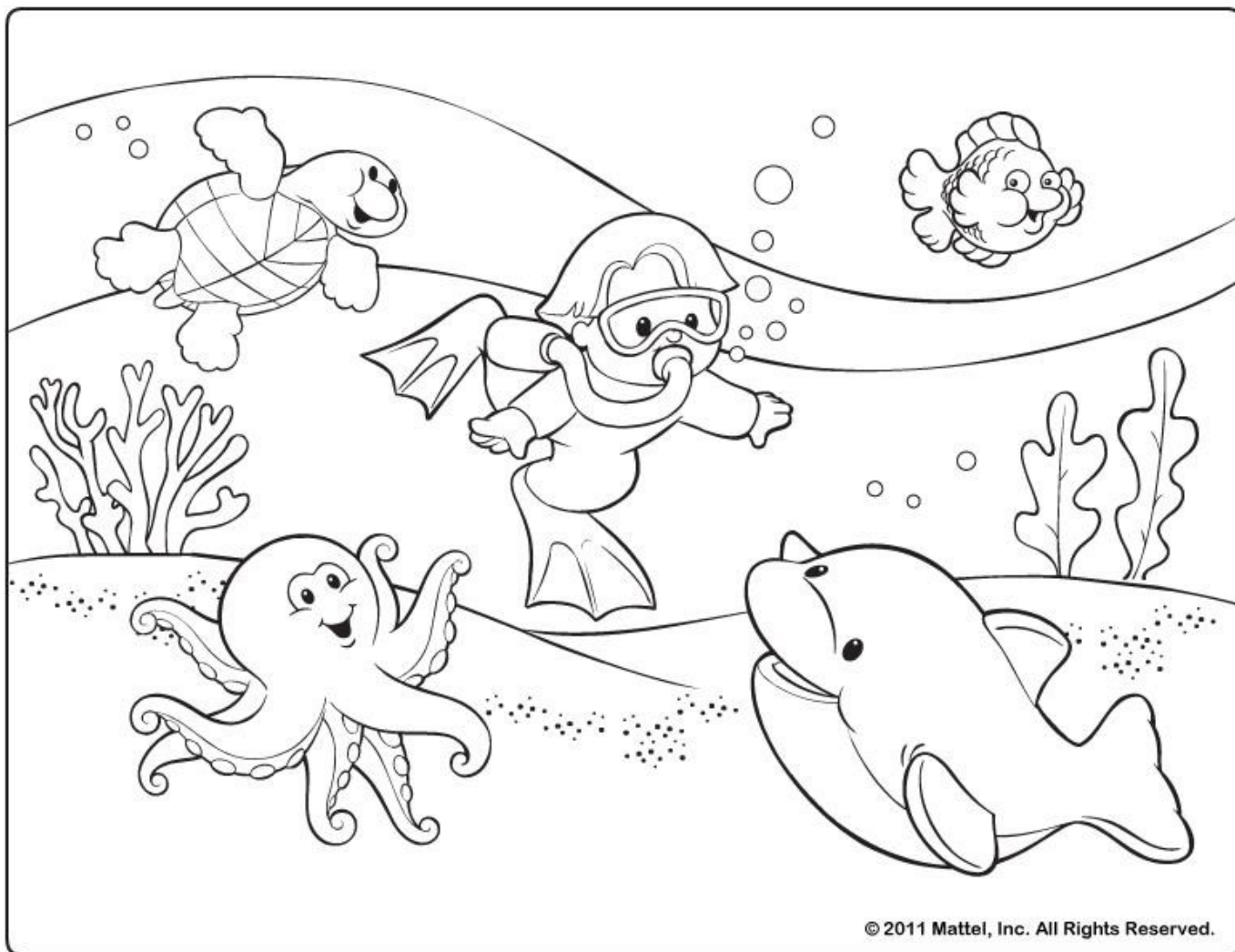
