BUDGET 2020/2021: Council adopted the budget for this financial year at their meeting on 05 August. The budget priority is to support local employment via a number of infrastructure projects.

The highlights of the budget include:

- no increase to rates and a reduction in the rate in the dollar for Holiday Accommodation;
- a carried forward surplus of \$1,098,796;
- an end of year position (Net Current Assets) of \$1,907,041;
- a capital works program of \$3,351,536;
- transfers of \$874,317 from reserves and a transfer of \$427,250 into reserves.

Council has also given much consideration to balancing provision of new infrastructure, identified and prioritized in the Maju Pulu Kita Masterplan, with the need to look after our existing infrastructure and improve our environmental sustainability.

See page 4 and 5 for the full list of infrastructure projects. In addition to the capital works, Council has approved expenditure on a number of one-off projects that enhance social, cultural, environmental and economic sustainability and strengthen our governance.

We would like to invite our stakeholders and members of the community to our budget presentations to hear details of the budget and gain a better understanding of how community funds are being managed.

Budget presentations will be held on:

- Wednesday 12 August at 4.35pm – Home Island Council Chambers; and
- Thursday 13 August at 4.15pm – West Island CRC Conference Room.

Anyone interested in knowing more about the projects planned for the coming year and to learn more about the financial management of the Shire is very welcome to attend.

BUDGET 2020/2021: *Konsel mengadopsi budget untuk tahun keuangan ini pada mitingan mereka pada 05 Ogas. Keutamaan budget adalah untuk menyokong pekerjaan lokal melalui sejumlah projek infrastruktur.*

Highlight budget termasuk:

- tidak ada kenaikan pada rates dan pengurangan rates dalam dolar untuk Tempat Tinggal Percutian;*
- lebih dibawa ke hadapan sebanyak \$1,098,796;*
- kedudukan akhir tahun (Net Current Assets) sebanyak \$1,907,041;*
- capital works program \$3,351,536;*
- pemindahan \$874,317 dari reserves dan pemindahan \$427,250 ke reserves.*

FROM THE CEO'S DESK - 07 AUGUST 2020

ECONOMIC STIMULUS FUNDING: The announcement by The Hon Nola Marino, Assistant Minister for Regional Development and Territories, of economic stimulus funding for Cocos (Keeling) Islands (CKI) was welcome news. The Shire is delighted to partner with the Australian Government to deliver several of these projects to the community. The Australian Government funding, along with the Shire's matching contribution, will allow two new homes to be built on Home Island, the first new houses to be built since 2004. Funding will also allow for the Home Island Retail Centre to be refurbished and expanded, another project that has been a long-standing priority for this community.

Both projects will provide a wonderful boost to the economy via employment opportunities and will result in lasting social outcomes that will benefit our community for many years to come.

We offer our sincere thanks to Minister Marino and our Administrator, Natasha Griggs for their ongoing support and tireless efforts on behalf of the CKI community and look forward to bringing these projects to fruition in the coming year.

PACKAGE BANTUAN EKONOMI: Pengumuman oleh Hon Nola Marino, Assistant Minister untuk Regional Development dan Territories, mengenai duit bantuan ekonomi untuk Kepulauan Cocos (Keeling) (CKI) adalah berita baik. Konsel dengan senang hati bekerjasama dengan Kerajaan Australia untuk menyampaikan beberapa projek ini kepada masyarakat. Funding Kerajaan Australia, bersama dengan sumbangan yang sepadan dengan Konsel, akan membolehkan membuat dua rumah baru di Kampong, rumah baru pertama yang dibuat sejak 2004.

Bantuan uang juga akan membolehkan Retail Centre di Kampong dibaguskan dan dibesarkan, satu lagi projek yang telah menjadi keutamaan lama bagi masyarakat ini.

Kedua-dua projek ini akan memberikan dorongan hebat bagi ekonomi melalui peluang pekerjaan dan akan menghasilkan hasil sosial yang berkekalan yang akan memberi manfaat kepada masyarakat kami selama bertahun-tahun yang akan datang.

Kami mengucapkan terima kasih yang tulus kepada Minister Marino dan Administrator kami, Natasha Griggs atas sokongan mereka yang berterusan dan usaha mereka bagi masyarakat CKI dan berharap dapat melaksanakan projek-projek ini pada tahun yang akan datang.

ADOPT-A-SPOT PROGRAM: At their meeting on Wednesday this week, Council also made a small but important change to the Community Funding Program Policy. The Policy now requires all applicants to have participated in the Adopt-a-spot program before applying for Community Funding Grants from the Shire. The Adopt-a-spot program engages community groups to undertake clean-ups at a site of their choice in the community whilst receiving cash rewards for every bag of rubbish collected. The program not only provides community groups with funding assistance but

also an easy way to do something simple to look after the environment and helps increase public awareness of the effects of littering. Sites include but are not limited to roadsides, streets, parks, trails and beaches. Participants will be provided with equipment and support. To find out more about this great fund-raising initiative, please contact Isa Minkom at the Shire.

PROGRAM ADOPT-A-SPOT: Pada pertemuan mereka pada hari Rabu minggu ini, Konsel juga membuat perubahan kecil tetapi penting pada Community Funding Program Policy. Policy sekarang mengharuskan semua pemohon untuk terlibat dalam program Adopt-a-spot sebelum memohon Community Funding dari Shire. Program Adopt-a-spot melibatkan kumpulan masyarakat untuk melakukan pembersihan di lokasi pilihan mereka di masyarakat sambil menerima duit untuk setiap beg sampah yang dikumpulkan. Program ini bukan sahaja memberi bantuan uang kepada kumpulan masyarakat tetapi juga cara mudah untuk melakukan sesuatu yang sederhana untuk menjaga alam sekitar dan membantu meningkatkan kesedaran masyarakat mengenai kesan sampah. Tempat termasuk tetapi tidak terbatas kepada pinggir jalan, jalan, taman, trails dan pinggir laot. Peserta akan dibekalkan dengan bekakas dan sokongan. Free to download from the App Store and Google Play, Snap Send Solve is a platform that eliminates the complexity of knowing where and how to report incidents on the spot. All our residents are encouraged to report issues with trees, wasps, pavement problems, dumped rubbish or any areas of concern in the local community via the application.

Easy for community members to use, reports using Snap Send Solve take less than 30 seconds to make.

1. Open the App
2. Start a New Report
3. Snap a photo
4. Confirm your location (the app uses GPS to locate the user)
5. Confirm the incident type
6. Press send

The application forwards the incident through to the correct council or relevant authority.

"LAWA's IOTs Service is fully funded by the Australian Government"**How the Office of the eSafety Commissioner can help you**

These are short articles about legal issues that may interest you. They are not legal advice. You should always get individual legal advice for your situation.

This is the first article of three about the Office of the eSafety Commissioner (we will now call it just the eSafety Commissioner, or Commissioner). In this article we will look at the purpose of the eSafety Commissioner, how the Commissioner's Office was set up, the legal powers the Commissioner has and the main areas of work of the Commissioner. We will then look at those areas of work in more detail in this and the next two articles.

The eSafety Commissioner is a Commonwealth government agency set up to help people stay safe online and deal with problems they can have from being online.

These problems might include cyberbullying (online bullying), others posting intimate images of them online without their consent, seeing illegal or harmful content online (such as child sex abuse or very violent material) and trying to keep personal data safe.

The eSafety Commissioner states as its purposes, to:

- help keep safe those Australians who are at risk from online harms and
- promote safer, more positive online experiences.

The eSafety Commissioner was set up under the *Enhancing Online Safety Act 2015*. The Act gives the Commissioner various legal powers to do things to help keep people safe online.

These legal powers include:

- investigating certain complaints (for example, about serious cyberbullying of children, intimate image-based abuse and harmful or illegal material on the internet)
- making requests or issuing notices to social media services to remove material
- issuing notices to people posting or threatening to post material online
- issuing formal warnings
- issuing infringement notices (like "on-the-spot" fines, but which are not criminal under this legislation)
- applying to a court for a civil penalty order (a non-criminal monetary penalty) or an injunction (an order of the court stopping someone doing something, or making them do something)
- requiring apologies
- accepting enforceable undertakings (a promise from someone to do or not to do something which can be enforced)
- giving directions to service providers or telecommunications carriers (eg after the attack on the Christchurch mosque that killed 51 people, the eSafety Commissioner gave a direction to internet service providers (ISPs) to block websites that gave access to the alleged offender's video and manifesto)
- powers under other Acts, such as the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*.

The eSafety Commissioner has six main areas of work. These are:

- Responding to complaints about intimate image-based abuse of people.
- Responding to complaints about serious cyberbullying (online bullying) of children.
- Responding to complaints about harmful and illegal content online such as child sex abuse, or extremely violent material.
- Providing online safety information and help through its website.
- Providing online education and training.
- Responding to specific needs as they are identified, by developing programs and special projects.

We will now look at these areas in more detail in the rest of this article and in the next two articles.

Responding to complaints about intimate image abuse of people

The Commissioner's office run a complaints and objections scheme for intimate image-based abuse.

Intimate image-based abuse is posting or threatening to post videos or photos of:

- your genital or anal areas or breasts, naked or only covered by underwear
- you undressing, having sex, going to the toilet or bathing or
- you without your religious clothing if you normally wear it in public

on social media, websites, messenger services and email, without your consent.

A complaint is for where you never consented at all for the intimate image to be posted. An objection is for where you originally consented to the image being shared, but have changed your mind and now want it removed. How to make a complaint or an objection is explained step by step on the website.

The complaint can be dealt with in various ways, depending on the circumstances. The Commissioner can:

- make a request or issue an enforceable removal notice to the social media service to remove the intimate image material
- issue an enforceable removal notice to the person who has posted the material
- issue a formal warning to the person who has posted or threatened to post the material
- give an infringement notice (a non-criminal "on-the-spot" fine) to the person who has posted or threatened to post the material
- apply to a court for a civil (not criminal) penalty order (a monetary punishment) against the person who has posted or threatened to post the material, where you have not consented at any time to it being posted (if you originally consented to it being posted, but want it removed, the Commissioner cannot apply for a civil penalty order)
- apply to a court for an injunction (an order of the court stopping someone doing something, or making them do something).

Ini adalah artikel pendek mengenai masalah undang-undang yang mungkin menarik bagi anda. Ini bukan nasihat undang-undang. Anda harus selalu mendapatkan nasihat undang-undang masing-masing untuk keadaan anda.

Ini adalah artikel pertama dari tiga mengenai Pejabat Commissioner eSafety (kami akan menyebutnya sebagai Commissioner eSafety, atau Commissioner). Dalam artikel ini kami akan melihat tujuan Commissioner eSafety, bagaimana Pejabat Commissioner didirikan, kekuatan hukum yang dimiliki Commissioner dan pekerjaan utama Commissioner. Kami kemudian akan melihat bidang pekerjaan secara lebih terperinci dalam artikel ini dan dua artikel berikutnya.

Commissioner eSafety adalah agensi kerajaan Komanwel yang diberdirikan untuk membantu orang-orang agar tetap selamat saat online dan menangani masalah yang mereka hadapi saat online.

Masalah ini mungkin termasuk cyberbullying (bullying online), yang lain menyiarkan gambar intim mereka secara online tanpa persetujuan mereka, melihat kandungan yang haram atau berbahaya saat online (seperti penderaan seks anak-anak atau konten yang sangat ganas) dan cuba menjaga keselamatan data peribadi.

Commissioner eSafety menyatakan bahawa tujuannya adalah:

- bantu menjaga keselamatan warga Australia yang berisiko daripada bahaya online dan
- mempromosikan pengalaman online yang lebih selamat dan positif.

Commissioner eSafety diberdirikan di bawah Undang-Undang Keselamatan Online 2015. Undang-undang ini memberi Commissioner berbagai kuasa hukum untuk melakukan sesuatu untuk membantu menjaga keselamatan orang saat online.

Kekuatan hukum ini termasuk:

- menyelidiki komplek tertentu (contohnya, mengenai cyberbullying anak-anak yang serius, penyalahgunaan berdasarkan gambar intim dan benda berbahaya atau haram di internet)
- membuat permintaan atau mengeluarkan notis ke media sosial untuk menyabut gambar
- mengeluarkan notis kepada orang yang mengepos atau mengancam untuk menghantar gambar online
- mengeluarkan amaran rasmi
- mengeluarkan notis pelanggaran (seperti denda "di tempat", tetapi yang tidak jenayah berdasarkan undang-undang ini)
- memohon kepada mahkamah untuk perintah hukuman sivil (hukuman bukan jenayah) atau perintah (perintah mahkamah menghentikan seseorang melakukan sesuatu, atau membuat mereka melakukan sesuatu)
- memerlukan permintaan maaf
- menerima janji yang boleh dilaksanakan (janji dari seseorang untuk melakukan atau tidak melakukan sesuatu yang boleh dilaksanakan)
- memberi arahan kepada penyedia perkhidmatan atau operator telekomunikasi (contohnya setelah serangan di masjid Christchurch yang mengorbankan 51 orang, Commissioner eSafety memberi arahan kepada penyedia perkhidmatan internet (ISP) untuk menyekat laman web yang memberikan akses ke video dan manifesto yang didakwa pesalah)
- kuasa di bawah Undang-Undang lain, seperti Undang-Undang Perkhidmatan Penyiaran 1992.

Commissioner eSafety mempunyai enam bidang pekerjaan utama. Ini adalah:

- Menjawab komplek mengenai penyalahgunaan orang berdasarkan gambar yang intim.
- Menjawab komplek mengenai cyberbullying yang serius (buli online) anak-anak.
- Menjawab komplek mengenai kandungan berbahaya dan haram saat online seperti penderaan seks anak-anak, atau gambar yang sangat ganas.
- Memberi maklumat dan bantuan keselamatan online melalui laman webnya.
- Menyediakan pendidikan dan latihan secara online.
- Membalas keperluan spesifik seperti yang diidentifikasi, dengan mengembangkan program dan projek khas.

Kami sekarang akan melihat bidang-bidang ini dengan lebih terperinci dalam artikel ini dan dua artikel berikutnya.

Menjawab komplek mengenai penyalahgunaan gambar intim

Opis Commissioner menjalankan scheme komplek dan bantahan untuk penyalahgunaan berdasarkan gambar.

Penyalahgunaan adalah menyiarkan gambar intim atau mengancam untuk menyiarkan video atau gambar:

- kawasan kemaluan atau dubur atau payudara anda, telanjang atau hanya ditutupi seluar dalam
- anda menanggalkan pakaian, melakukan hubungan seks, pergi ke tandas atau mandi atau
- anda tanpa pakaian agama jika anda biasanya memakainya di luar

di media sosial, laman web, messenger dan e-mel, tanpa kebenaran anda.

Komplek adalah di mana anda tidak pernah bersetuju sama sekali untuk gambar intim disiarkan. Keberatan adalah untuk di mana pada awalnya anda menyetujui gambar dikongsi, tetapi telah berubah fikiran dan sekarang mahu gambar tersebut dicabut. Cara membuat komplek atau bantahan dijelaskan langkah demi langkah di laman web.

Komplek tersebut dapat diatasi dengan berbagai cara, bergantung pada keadaan. Commissioner boleh:

- membuat permintaan atau mengeluarkan notis penghapusan yang boleh dilaksanakan kepada perkhidmatan media sosial untuk mencabut gambar intim
- mengeluarkan notis penyingkiran yang boleh dilaksanakan kepada orang yang telah menghantar gambar tersebut
- mengeluarkan amaran rasmi kepada orang yang telah mengepos atau mengancam untuk menghantar gambar tersebut
- memberikan notis pelanggaran (bukan penjenayah denda "di tempat") kepada orang yang telah mengepos atau mengancam untuk menghantar gambar tersebut
- memohon kepada mahkamah untuk perintah hukuman sivil (bukan jenayah) (hukum bayaran) terhadap orang yang telah mengepos atau mengancam untuk menghantar gambar tersebut, di mana anda tidak pernah bersetuju untuk menghantarnya (jika pada awalnya anda bersetuju untuk dipos, tetapi mahu dicabut, Commissioner tidak boleh memohon perintah hukuman sivil)
- memohon kepada mahkamah untuk injunksi (perintah mahkamah menghentikan seseorang melakukan sesuatu, atau membuat mereka melakukan sesuatu).
