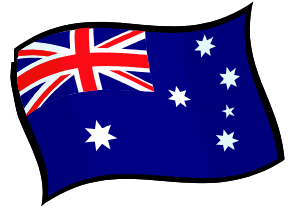

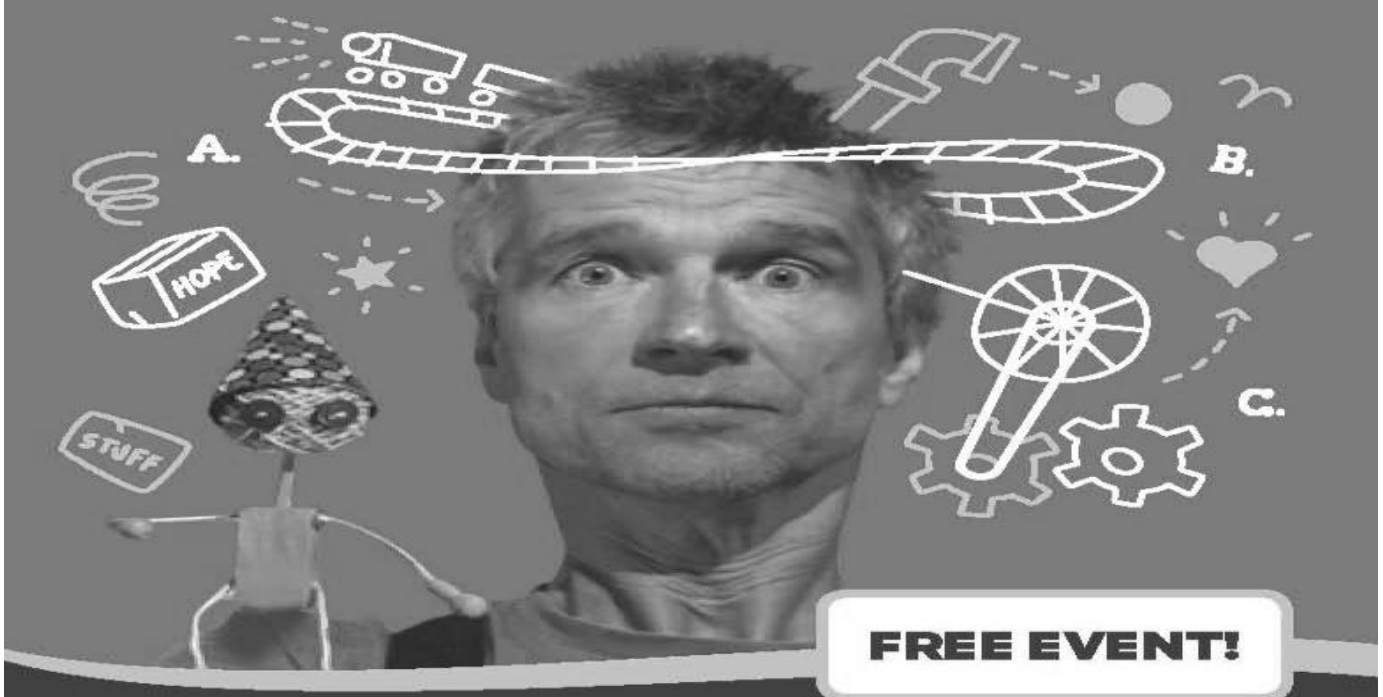

Tips for a more environmentally friendly wedding

Weddings are generally a nightmare of hyper-consumption and produce a great deal of waste. There's invitations, decorations, gifts, travel, clothing and the list goes on. Many of the items used at a wedding are only used once.

Invitations and paper Use recycled paper

wherever possible for wedding invitations; most companies can offer this option. Also consider treeless paper made from materials such as bamboo, hemp and kenaf. Even the type of ink used for the invitation should be taken into account as some inks can be toxic.

Venue and Travel

When selecting a venue, also consider where your guests will be travelling from. Try and find a middle point if possible. The less your guest have to travel, the cheaper for them and the less oil consumed.

Cutlery and crockery

Disposable plates, cups, napkins and cutlery can create masses of waste at large wedding receptions. Consider hiring non-disposable cutlery and crockery instead. If that's not viable, try to use recycled paper products or treeless disposable crockery options such as bamboo.

Wedding dresses and clothing

If you have no desire to keep the dress after the wedding, donate it to a charity who can sell it, creating funds for them and perhaps saving someone else from needing to purchase a new dress.

Changes to import conditions for fresh cut flowers and foliage into Christmas Island and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands

On 1 March 2018, updated import conditions came into effect for fresh cut flowers and foliage imported into Christmas Island and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands.

From this date, to be imported without a permit, the fresh cut flowers and foliage must:

- (a) Be imported from the Australian mainland; **or**
- (b) Be listed fresh cut flowers or foliage; and
 - i. accompanied by evidence stating the botanical name (including genus and species), **or**
 - ii. in a quantity of not more than 6 small boxes, bouquets or equivalent, are for personal use, and are brought in as baggage.

Some species still require a permit and additional requirements apply, such as lilies (*Lilium spp*).

Perubahan kepada syarat-syarat impot bunga dan tumbuhan segar ke Pulu Krismas dan Pulu Kokos-Keeling

Pada 1 Mac 2018, syarat-syarat pengimpotan yang telah dikemaskini akan mula berkuatkuasa ke atas bunga dan tumbuhan segar yang diimpot ke Pulu Krismas dan Pulu Kokos-Keeling.

Mulai tarikh ini, untuk diimpot tanpa permit, bunga dan tumbuhan segar mestilah:

- (a) Diimpot dari tanah besar Australia; **atau**
- (b) Bunga atau tumbuhan segar yang sudah disenarai; dan
 - i. diiringi bahan bukti yang menyatakan nama botaninya (termasuk genus dan spesies), **atau**
 - ii. dalam jumlah yang tidak melebihi 6 kotak kecil, jambangan atau sebagainya, untuk kegunaan peribadi dan dibawa masuk sebagai bagasi.

Sesetengah spesies masih memerlukan permit dan akan dikenakan syarat-syarat tambahan, contohnya bunga lily (*Lilium spp*).

Anxiety

Drug offences and you VIII – Commonwealth drug offences – trafficking illegal drugs

These are short articles about legal issues that may interest you. They are not legal advice. You should always get individual legal advice for your situation.

This is the eighth article about drug offences under state-based legislation that is applied to Christmas and Cocos (Keeling) Islands and under Commonwealth legislation.

This is the fourth article about Commonwealth drug offences – that is, offences under Commonwealth legislation. It is about trafficking offences associated with illegal drugs (these are called “controlled drugs”).

The *Criminal Code Act 1995 (Cth)* (we will call it the *Criminal Code (Cth)*) and the *Criminal Code Regulations 2002 (Cth)* (we will call them the *Regulations*) deal with Commonwealth drug offences.

What is a controlled drug?

The *Criminal Code (Cth)* defines a “controlled drug” as one listed as such by a regulation, or an analogue (which means another similar form) of the drug or one that is urgently determined by the Minister to be a controlled drug.

The *Regulations* contain a schedule listing them. Examples include heroin, cocaine, ecstasy, amphetamine and metamphetamine, among others. The definition does not include growing plants.

What is trafficking?

You traffic in a controlled drug if you:

- sell it
- possess it with the intention of selling it
- prepare it for supply, or transport it with the intention of selling it or believing that someone else intends to sell any of it
- guard or hide it with the intention of selling it or assisting someone else to sell any of it.

So, holding onto the controlled drug with the intention of selling it in the future is trafficking. Packaging it into separate amounts, such as baggies, ready to sell is preparing the drug for supply. Burying the drug in your backyard until you are ready to sell is hiding it with the intention of selling.

When you can be presumed to be trafficking

If you have a certain amount or more of any controlled drug (called a trafficable quantity), or you have done certain things with a trafficable quantity (such as transported it, or prepared it for supply) you can be presumed to be intending either to sell it or to believe that someone else will do so, just because of the large amount that you have.

You can rebut (cancel) the presumption if you can prove that you did not have that intention or belief. The standard of proof is just on the balance of probabilities, which means just greater than 50 percent, or more likely than not.

The trafficable quantity for each drug is set out in the schedule in the *Regulations* that lists controlled drugs and is measured in grams. Examples are 2 grams of amphetamine, 1.5 grams of morphine and 0.002 grams of lysergide (LSD).

“Marketable” and “commercial” amounts of controlled drugs

In general terms, you can be charged with trafficking the controlled drug (the least serious charge), or trafficking a “marketable” quantity of the controlled drug (a more serious charge) or trafficking a “commercial” quantity of the controlled drug (the most serious charge).

The schedule that lists controlled drugs also set out the amounts that constitute marketable and commercial quantities of each drug. A “marketable” quantity is usually measured in grams. Some examples are if you have 250 grams or more of amphetamine, cocaine or heroin or 500 or more grams of ketamine.

A “commercial” quantity is usually measured in kilograms. Some examples are if you have 1.5 kgs or more of heroin, or 0.75 kgs or more of amphetamine or 2 kgs or more of cocaine.

Trafficking controlled drugs – the offences

If you traffic a controlled drug you commit an offence. The maximum penalty is 10 years imprisonment or 2,000 penalty units (a penalty unit (PU) is currently \$210) or both. This offence can be dealt with by a Magistrates Court if both the accused person and the prosecution agree to do so.

If you traffic a marketable quantity of a controlled drug you commit an offence. The maximum penalty is 25 years imprisonment or 5,000 PUs or both. This offence is indictable only. This means that it can only be dealt with by the District Court and not by the Magistrates Court.

If you traffic a commercial quantity of a controlled drug you have commit an offence. The maximum penalty is imprisonment for life or 7,500 PUs or both. This offence is indictable only and can only be dealt with by the Supreme Court, and not by the District Court, because the maximum penalty is life imprisonment.

With all of the offences mentioned in this article, you can also be found guilty of the offence if you are reckless (which means careless or unthinking) as to whether what you are trafficking is a controlled drug or not.

In the next article we will talk about cultivating illegal plants for commercial purposes and selling plants.

Pelanggaran drug dan kamu VIII – Pelanggaran drug menurut Commonwealth – perdagangan drug yang dilarang

Ini adalah majalah pendek tentang perkara-perkaraperundangan yang mungkin menarik perhatian kamu. Ia bukan nasihat legal. Kamu harus selalu mengambil nasihat legal tersendiri untuk keadaan kamu.

Ini majalah yang ke delapan tentang pelanggaran drug menurut perundangan berdasarkan state yang digunakan di Pulu Christmas dan Cocos (Keeling) dan dibawa perundangan Commonwealth.

Ini majalah yang keempat tentang pelanggaran drug menurut Commonwealth – iaitu, pelanggaran dibawa undang-undang Commonwealth. Ia tentang pelanggaran perdagangan yang berkenaan dengan drug terlarang (ini dipanggil "drug yang dijaga")

Criminal Code Act 1995 (Cth) (kita akan memanggil Criminal Code (Cth) dan Criminal Code Regulations 2002 (Cth) (kita akan memanggil Regulations) berurusan dengan pelanggaran drug menurut Commonwealth.

Apa itu drug yang dijaga?

Criminal Code (Cth) menerangkan "drug yang dijaga dalam tempatan" sebagai salahsatu yang didaftarkan oleh sebuah undang-undang, atau sesuatu yang sama, atau drug yang dengan segera dinyatakan oleh Minister untuk menjadi drug yang dijaga dalam tempatan. Daftaran dalam Perundangan menerangkannya. Contohnya termasuk heroin, cocaine, ecstasy, amphetamine, dan methamphetamine, diantaranya.

Apa itu perdagangan?

Kamu memperdagangkan drug terjaga kalau kamu:

- menjualnya
- mempunyainya dengan bertujuan untuk menjualnya
- menyediakannya untuk persediaan, atau transport dengan tujuan untuk dijual atau mempercayai yang orang lain berniat untuk menjualnya
- menjaga atau menyembunyikannya dengan tujuan untuk menjualnya atau membantu orang lain untuk menjualnya.

Jadi, memegang drug terjaga dengan bertujuan untuk menjualnya dimasa hadapan adalah perdagangan. Dipacking dan dibagi kedalam beg-beg, disiapkan untuk dijual ialah dipersiapkan untuk persediaan jualan. Menanam drug didalam belakang kebon hingga masanya siap untuk dijual ialah menyembunyikan dengan bertujuan untuk dijual.

Bila kamu dianggap berperdagangan

Kalau kamu mempunyai jumlah drug jagaan yang lebih (dipanggil jumlah perdagangan), atau kamu telah berbuat sesuatu dengan jumlah yang boleh diperdagangkan (seperti di transport, atau menyiapkannya untuk sediaan) kamu boleh dianggap untuk bertujuan untuk menjual atau dipercayai yang orang lain yang akan menjual, disebabkan jumlah yang banyak yang kamu mempunyai.

Kamu boleh membatalkan anggapan ini kalau kamu boleh buktikan yang kamu tidak ada tujuan untuk keperluan itu. Standard bukti ini hanya dalam timbangan berkemungkinan, yang bermaksud melebihi 50 percent, atau lebih yang tidak.

Jumlah yang digelarkan untuk perdagangan untuk setiap drug telah diterangkan dalam daftar Regulations yang menerangkan drug yang dijaga dan ditimbang dalam grams. Contohnya ialah 2 grams amphetamine, 1.5 grams morphine dan 0.002 grams lysergide (LSD).

Jumlah "Jualan" dan "jualan commercial" drug yang dijaga

Secara umumnya, kamu boleh didakwa dengan perdagangan drug yang dijaga (dakwaan ringan), atau perdagangan drug yang dijaga berjumlah "jualan"(dakwaan yang lebih berat) atau perdagangan drug yang dijaga berjumlah "jualan commercial" (dakwaan yang paling berat).

Daftar yang menerangkan drug yang dijaga juga menerangkan jumlah yang digelarkan boleh dijual dan jumlah jualan commercial untuk setiap drug. Jumlah "jualan" biasanya ditimbang dalam grams. Contoh-contohnya ialah kalau kamu mempunyai 250 grams atau lebih amphetamine, cocaine atau heroin atau 500 gram atau lebih ketamine.

Jumlah "jualan commercial" biasanya ditimbang dalam kilograms. Some examples are if you have 1.5 kgs or more of heroin, or 0.75 kgs or more of amphetamine or 2 kgs or more of cocaine.

Trafficking drug yang dijaga – pelanggarannya

Kalau kamu berdagang drug jagaan, kamu membuat pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah 10 tahun dipenjarakan atau 2,000 penalty units (penalty unit (PU) dimasa sekarang \$210) atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh diurus dengan Magistrates Court kalau kedua-dua orang yang dituduh dan pendakwanya bersetuju.

Kalau kamu berdagang drug jagaan yang berjumlah jualan kamu membuat pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah 25 tahun dipenjarakan atau 5,000 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh didakwa sahaja. Ini bermaksud yang ia hanya boleh diurus oleh District Court dan bukan oleh Magistrates Court.

Kalau kamu berdagang jumlah jualan commercial drug yang dijaga kamu telah membuat pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah dipenjarakan seumur hidup atau 7,500 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh didakwa sahaja dan hanya boleh diurus oleh Supreme Court, dan bukan oleh District Court, bersebabkan hukuman maksimum ialah dipenjarakan seumur hidup.

Dengan semua pelanggaran yang tersebut dalam majalah ini, kamu juga boleh didapati bersalah dalam pelanggaran jika kamu ceroboh (yang bermaksud ceroboh dan tidak berfikir) dalam kemungkinan kamu berdagang drug yang dijaga ataupun tidak.

Dalam majalah seterusnya kami akan berbincang tentang penanaman tumbuhan terlarang untuk tujuan commercial dan jualan tumbuhan itu.

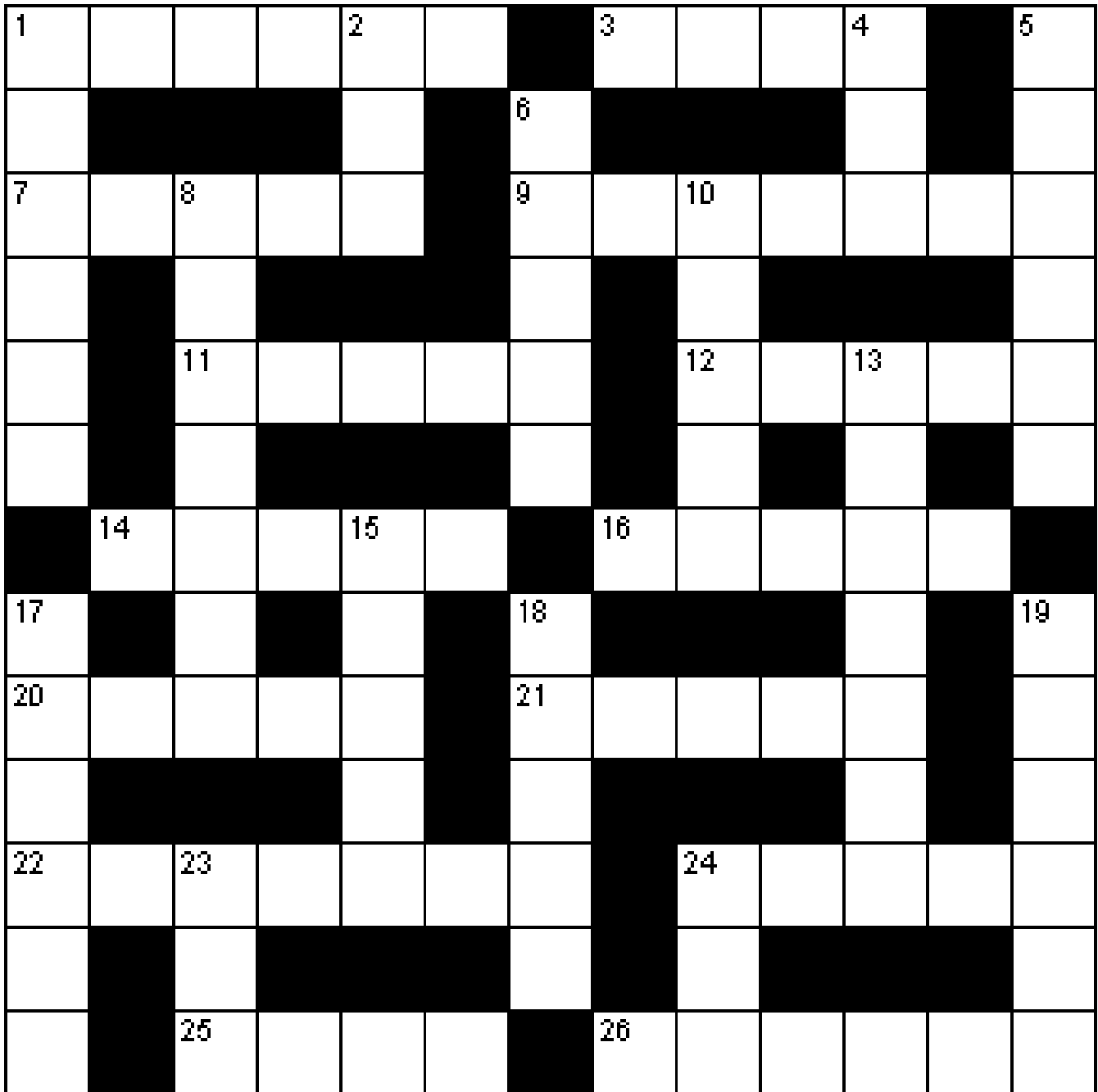

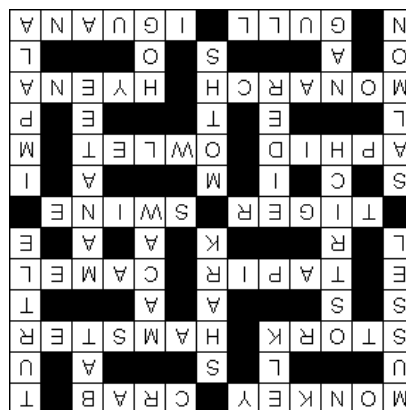

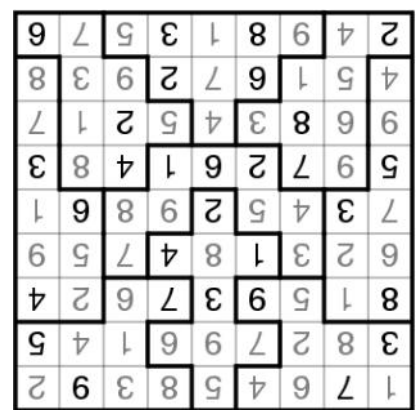
