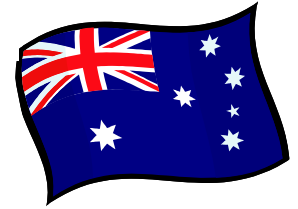

### KEEPING OF CHICKENS IN BACKYARDS

The Shire Ranger would like to remind that 12 weeks old chickens should be re-located at the designated area (Garden plot).

Chicken pens should not be placed straight onto the ground behind back backyards at any time.

I would like advise that all chicken pens carrying less than 12 weeks chicks should carry a 'catchment device' or tray underneath pens to catch waste and to avoid waste from entering straight through the ground.

Have you ever thought of cleaning with bicarb soda? It truly is magical stuff! Here are some magical ways you can use the humble bicarb soda (sodium bicarbonate, baking soda) to clean and deodorise your kitchen.

1. Cleans your chopping boards .

Wooden and plastic boards can be refreshed by giving them a scrub with a paste of a tablespoon each of bicarb, salt and water. Rinse the boards afterwards.

2. Removes stains from your kitchen bench top.

Make a paste of 2 parts bicarb to 1 part water and apply to stains on your bench tops, gently rubbing in a circular motion, then wipe clean.

3. Deodorises your garbage and recycling bin.

Wipe the inside of your bin with a damp cloth sprinkled with bicarb, then rinse. Once dry, you can sprinkle a little bicarb in the bottom to keep it smelling fresh.

4. Cleans stainless steel sink.

Wet your sink, sprinkle baking soda over the surface, scrub, and then rinse before lining the sink with vinegar-soaked paper towel for 20mins. Use a soft toothbrush with a bicarb paste to scrub sink rim and caulk. Your sink will sparkle.

5. Takes out coffee and tea stains.

Put teapots, coffee plungers, pots and mugs in sink with 1 part bicarb to 4 parts water. Soak for 15 minutes and rinse.

## Drug offences and you V – Commonwealth drug offences – possessing illegal drugs/plants

These are short articles about legal issues that may interest you. They are not legal advice. You should always get individual legal advice for your situation.

This is the fifth in a number of articles about drug offences under state-based legislation that is applied to Christmas and Cocos (Keeling) Islands and under Commonwealth legislation. The first four articles were about offences under the state-based *Misuse of Drugs Act 1981 (WA)(CI)* and *Misuse of Drugs Act 1981 (WA)(CKI)*.

In this next set of articles we will talk about Commonwealth illegal drug offences – that is, offences under Commonwealth legislation. Commonwealth legislation applies to the Islands.

The *Criminal Code Act 1995 (Cth)* (we will call it the *Criminal Code (Cth)*) and the *Criminal Code Regulations 2002 (Cth)* (we will call them the *Regulations*) deal with Commonwealth drug offences. The types of drug offences can be loosely grouped into possession, importation/exportation, trafficking, pre-trafficking of precursors, commercial cultivation and manufacturing offences.

This and the next article will talk about Commonwealth drug possession offences.

Drug 'possession' means that you actually have the drug, or have control of it, or you have it stored in a place where you have the ability or the right to get it. It includes solely or jointly owing it.

Commonwealth drug possession offences are of 2 kinds:

- Possession offences which are not linked to importation of the drug or plant and
- Possession offences involving the drug or plant forms of the drug that have been unlawfully Imported (or for which there is a reasonable suspicion that it has been unlawfully imported).

Possession offences not associated with importing might involve possessing an illegal drug (these are called "controlled drugs") or its precursors, possessing instructions for manufacturing or cultivating commercial quantities of plants or drugs, or possessing equipment for doing that.

### Some definitions

The *Criminal Code (Cth)* defines a "controlled drug" as one listed as such by a regulation, or an analogue (another similar form) of the drug or one that is urgently determined by the Minister to be a controlled drug. The *Regulations* contain a schedule listing (naming) them. Some examples are heroin, cocaine, ecstasy, amphetamine, and metamphetamine. It does not include growing plants.

A precursor is a substance necessary for the manufacture of the illegal drug. The *Criminal Code (Cth)* defines a "controlled precursor" as listed as such by a regulation, or a particular chemical relative of the precursor, or one that is urgently determined by the Minister to be a controlled precursor. The *Regulations* contain a schedule listing them. Examples are ephedrine (a precursor for metamphetamine) and lysergic acid (a precursor for LSD).

The *Criminal Code (Cth)* defines a "controlled plant" as one listed as such by a regulation, or one that is urgently determined by the Minister to be a controlled plant. The *Regulations* list all species of the genus cannabis as controlled plants. There are 3 species of cannabis generally recognised.

### Possession offences where no importation of drugs

If you possess a substance which is:

- a controlled drug or
- a controlled precursor and intend to use it to make a controlled drug you commit an offence. The maximum penalty is imprisonment for 2 years or 400 penalty units (a penalty unit ("PU") is currently \$210) or both. You can also be found guilty of the offence if you are reckless as to whether it is a controlled drug or controlled precursor or not.

If you possess larger quantities of the drug, or sell it, or intend to sell it, or do certain things with the intention of selling it or believing someone else will or helping someone else to do so, you can be charged with more serious offences. There are also more serious offences involving precursors. We will talk about all of these offences in a later article.

If you possess:

- a plant or plant material, equipment or any document containing instructions for growing a controlled plant and
- intend to use it to cultivate a controlled plant and
- intend to sell or believe someone else intends to sell the plant or products of the plant you commit an offence. The maximum penalty is imprisonment for 7 years or 1,400 PUs or both.

If you possess:

- any substance (that is not a precursor eg a tablet press), any equipment or any document containing instructions for making a controlled drug and
- intend to sell or believe someone else intends to sell the drug made you commit an offence. The maximum penalty is imprisonment for 7 years or 1,400 PUs or both.

The possession offences in this article can be dealt with by the Magistrates Court, if both the accused person and the prosecution agree. The next article will talk about possession offences that are associated with the importation of drugs.

## **Pelanggaran Drug dan kamu V – Pelanggaran drug Commonwealth – memiliki drug/tumbuhan terlarang**

Ini adalah majalah-majalah pendek tentang perkara-perkara legal yang mungkin kamu berminat. Ia bukan nasihat legal. Kamu mesti selalu mengambil nasihat legal tersendiri untuk keadaan kamu.

Ini yang kelima daripada berberapa majalah tentang pelanggaran drug menurut perundangan bahagian state yang dipergunakan di Pulu Christmas dan Cocos (Keeling) dan dibawa perundangan Commonwealth. Empat majalah terdahulunya tentang pelanggaran dibawa perundangan state Misuse of Drugs Act 1981 (WA) (CI) dan Misuse of Drugs Act 1981 (WA)(CKI).

Dalam set majalah-majalah seterusnya kami akan bincangkan tentang pelanggaran drug terlarang – iaitu, pelanggaran dibawa perundangan Commonwealth. Undang-undang Commonwealth dipergunakan di pulu.

*Criminal Code Act 1995 (Cth)* (kita panggil ini *Criminal Code (Cth)*) dan *Criminal Code Regulations 2002 (Cth)* (kita panggil *Regulations*) mengenai dengan pelanggaran drug menurut Commonwealth. Jenis-jenis pelanggaran drug boleh dikumpulkan kedalam pemilikan, pengimportan / pengeksporan, pemerdagangan, pengelakkan sebelum penyebaran, penanaman komersial dan kesalahan pembuatan.

Ini dan majalah seterusnya akan bicarakan tentang pelanggaran pemilikan drugs menurut Commonwealth.

'Pemilikan' drug berarti yang kamu ternyata ada drug dengan kamu, atau sedang mengurusinya, atau menyimpannya dalam tempat dimana kamu boleh mendapatinya. Ini termasuk tersendiri atau bersama-sama memilikinya dengan orang lain.

Pelanggaran memiliki drug menurut Commonwealth ada 2 jenis:

- Pelanggaran pemilik yang tidak dikaitkan dengan importasi drug atau tumbuhan; dan
- Pelanggaran pemilik yang termasuk jenis drug atau tumbuhan drug itu yang telah diimport secara haram (atau ada kecurigaan yang mungkin kuat yang ia di import secara haram).

Pelanggaran pemilik yang tidak berkenaan dengan import mungkin hanya terlibat dalam menyimpan drug terlarang ( ini dipanggil "controlled drugs") atau ia pendahulu, mempunyai arahan untuk pembuatan atau menanam kuantiti tumbuhan atau ubat komersial, atau memiliki peralatan untuk melakukan itu.

### **Beberapa definisi**

*Criminal Code (Cth)* menjelaskan "controlled drug" sebagai satu yang didaftarkan daripada undang-undang berkenaan, atau sebuah analog (bentuk lain yang serupa) drug atau satu yang segera ditentukan oleh Minister untuk menjadi sebuah 'controlled drug'. *Regulations* mengandungi daftaran nama. Contohnya heroin, cocaine, ecstasy, amphetamine, dan metamphetamine. Ia tidak termasuk tumbuhan.

Sebuah pendahulu adalah sesuatu keperluan untuk pembuatan drug terlarang. *Criminal Code (Cth)* menerangkan "controlled precursor" sebagai daftaran yang dinyatakan dalam undang-undang, atau sesuatu jenis chemical yang berkenaan pendahulu, atau satu yang dengan segera ditentukan oleh Minister sebagai 'controlled precursor'. *Regulations* mengandungi daftaran semua ini. Contohnya adalah ephedrine (sebuah pendahulu untuk metamphetamine) dan lysergic acid (sebuah pendahulu untuk LSD).

*Criminal Code (Cth)* menyatakan "controlled plant" sebagai yang di daftarkan oleh undang-undang, atau satu yang dengan segera ditentukan oleh Minister sebagai 'controlled plant'. *Regulations* mendaftarkan semua jenis genus cannabis sebagai 'controlled plants'. Ada 3 jenis cannabis yang biasanya dikenal.

### **Pelanggaran pemilik dimana drug tidak di import**

Kalau kamu memiliki sesuatu yang:

- sebuah 'controlled drug' atau
- sebuah 'controlled precursor' dan bertujuan untuk menggunakannya untuk membuat 'controlled drug' kamu melakukan pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah penjara 2 tahun atau 400 unit hukuman (unit hukuman ("PU") sekarang \$210) atau kedua-dua. Kamu juga boleh didapati bersalah kalau kamu ceroboh jika ianya 'controlled drug' atau 'controlled precursor' atau tidak.

Kalau kamu mempunyai jumlah drug yang lebih besar, atau menjualnya, atau bertujuan untuk dijual, atau buat perkara dengan tujuan untuk menjualnya atau percayakan orang lain atau membantu orang lain berbuat demikian, kamu boleh didakwa dengan pelanggaran yang lebih serius. Ada juga pelanggaran yang lebih serius yang melibatkan pendahulu. Kita akan bicarakan tentang pelanggaran-pelanggaran ini dimajalah selanjutnya.

Kalau kamu mempunyai:

- sebuah tumbuhan atau bahan tanaman, pekakas atau segala surat menyurat yang mengandungi arahan untuk menimbulkan 'controlled plant' dan
- berniat untuk menggunakannya untuk menanam controlled plant' dan
- bertujuan untuk menjual atau percaya orang lain yang bertujuan untuk menjual tumbuhan atau hasil tanaman itu kamu melakukan pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah penjara untuk 7 tahun atau 1,400 PUs atau kedua-duanya.

Kalau kamu mempunyai:

- barang apapun (yang bukan pendahulu, contohnya 'tablet press'), pekakas atau surat menyurat yang mengandungi arahan untuk membuat 'controlled drug' dan
- bertujuan untuk menjual atau percaya seorang lain bertujuan untuk menjual drug yang dibuat kamu melakukan pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah penjara 7 tahun atau 1,400 PUs atau kedua-duanya.

Pelanggaran pemilik dalam majalah ini boleh diurus oleh Magistrates Court, kalau kedua-dua orang yang dituduh dan pihak pendakwa bersetuju. Majalah seterusnya akan bincangkan tentang pelanggaran pemilik yang berkenaan dengan drug yang di import.

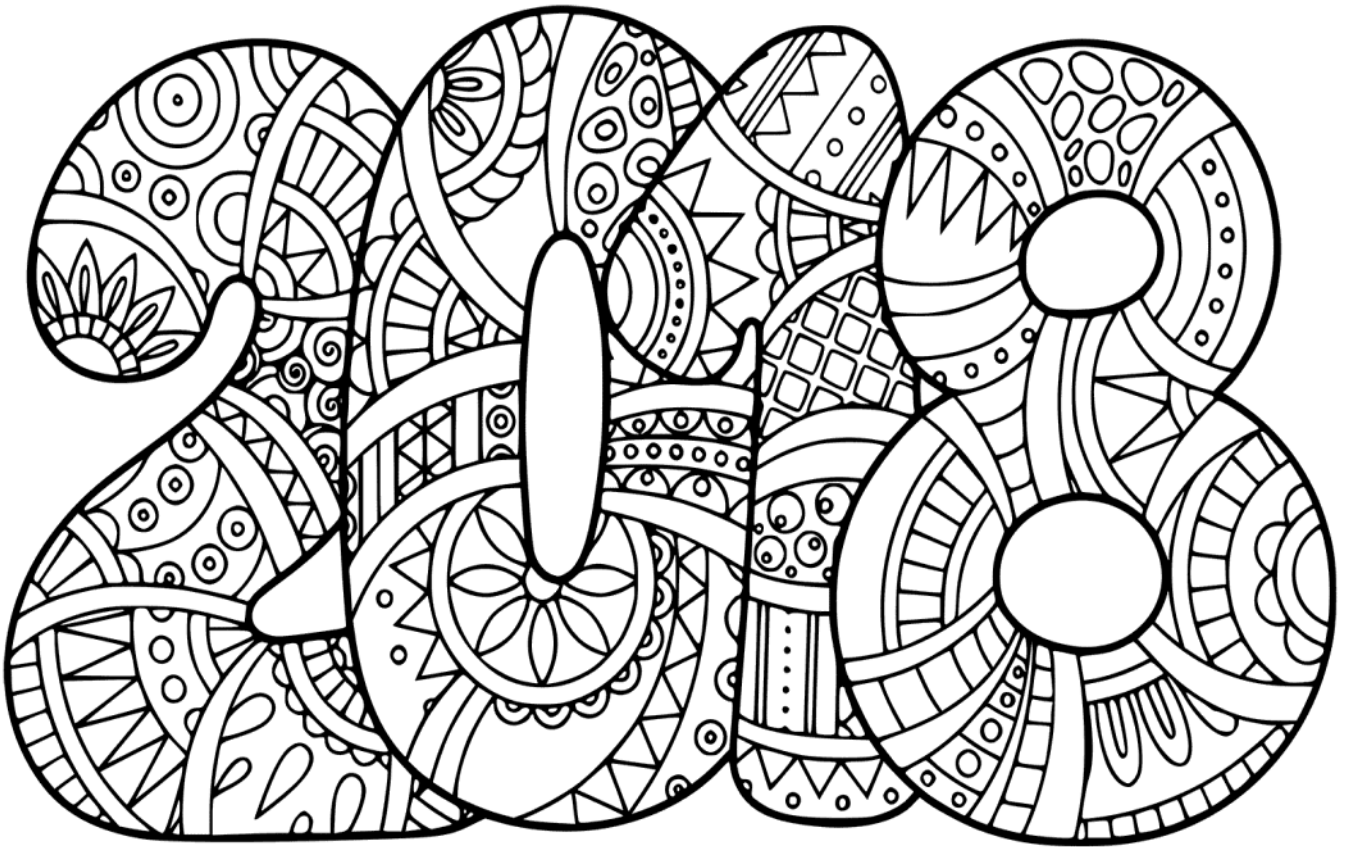
