### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS 2021 ARE YOU ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

Local Government elections will be held **SATURDAY, 16 OCTOBER 2021**. Now is the time to make sure you are enrolled to vote.

To be eligible to vote in the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands Elections, you must be over 18 and enrolled on the seat of Lingiari or the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands Owners and Occupiers roll. Voting in Local Government elections, while not compulsory, is an important way for you to connect with grassroots government.

Residents in the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands who are enrolled on the seat of Lingiari are automatically enrolled to vote in Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands elections.

If you are over 18 and not enrolled on the seat of Lingiari, you must submit an enrolment application.

If you have recently moved to the Shire, you must update your enrolment to the seat of Lingiari.

You can find the electoral form for Federal, State and Local Government Elections on [www.aec.gov.au](http://www.aec.gov.au)

#### PROPERTY OWNERS

If you are on the Electoral Roll for the seat of Lingiari for your normal address on Cocos you are automatically enrolled to vote in the local government election and need to do nothing more. However, if you **own** property on Cocos but are on the State Electoral Roll at an address outside the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands, you will need to apply to be added to the **owner's roll** for the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands in order to cast a vote.

#### OCCUPIERS

Do you rent or lease rateable property in the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands but are enrolled on a State Electoral Roll at an address outside the Shire? Do you know you may still be able to vote in the Shire? To claim a vote you will need to be added to the **occupiers roll** for the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands.

Enrolment claim forms can be obtained from the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands and should be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer at the Shire. **ENROLMENT CLOSES 4.00PM, FRIDAY 27 AUGUST 2021.**

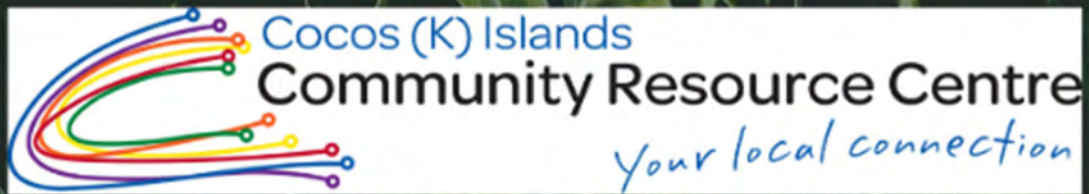

These are short articles about legal issues that may interest you. They are not legal advice. You should always get individual legal advice for your situation. This article and the next 3 articles will deal with "spent convictions". A spent conviction means that your conviction for a criminal offence is "spent", meaning wiped away, or gone. It is gone for many purposes, but not all.

You can have spent convictions for applied WA state law offences ("state-based offences") and for Commonwealth act offences ("Commonwealth offences").

For state-based offences, you can apply for and be granted a spent conviction:

- at the time that you are sentenced for the offence, when the court may make a spent conviction order "SCO", or
- after 10 years plus any period of imprisonment from the date of your last conviction, when the court can issue a certificate or make an order that the conviction is spent (commonly called "getting old convictions spent").

We will deal with the effects of having a state-based spent conviction in the second and third articles. We will deal with getting old state-based convictions spent and getting Commonwealth convictions spent in the fourth article.

**Applying for a spent conviction order (SCO) at the time you are sentenced for a state-based offence**

You cannot apply for an SCO at the time of sentencing if you are sentenced to:

- An intensive supervision order
- A conditional suspended period of imprisonment
- A suspended period of imprisonment
- A period of immediate imprisonment.

If you are on a pre-sentence order (an order that requires you to, for example, undertake some treatment before you are sentenced), you can only apply for an SCO if the offence is one that must be dealt with by the Magistrates Court (called a "simple" offence) and you have complied with the pre-sentence order.

The Court cannot make an SCO, unless it decides:

- that you are unlikely to commit this sort of offence again AND
- the offence was either trivial OR you have previous good character AND
- the Court considers that you should be relieved of the adverse (negative or bad) effects of a conviction.

An SCO is discretionary. Even if you satisfy the test, the Court may not make an SCO, because, for example, the offence is considered to be too serious.

Character references can help with your application for an SCO in several ways, which we will discuss below. Character references should:

- Be addressed to "The Presiding Magistrate".
- State that the writer knows that you are pleading guilty to whatever the offence is or offences are.
- Say how long the writer has known you, how they know you, why you are a person of good character, if you have expressed remorse, if they think the offence is out of character and if they think it is unlikely that you will commit this sort of offence again.
- Be dated and signed.

To show the Court that you are unlikely to commit this sort of offence again, it is useful if your character referees are willing to state that they think it is unlikely that you will commit this sort of offence again and why. It is also useful if you are able to tell the Court reasons why you are unlikely to commit this sort of offence again. For example, you may have committed an assault whilst drunk, and are now getting alcohol counselling and have stopped drinking alcohol. It is more difficult to satisfy this part of the test if you have committed this type of offence before.

Secondly, the Court must find that the offence is trivial (not serious at all) or that you have previous good character. Some offences that the Court has found to be trivial include the offence of disorderly conduct by urinating and possession of very small amounts of cannabis, among others. Many offences are not trivial and people rely instead on trying to show the Court that they have previous good character.

There are several ways to help show the Court that you have previous good character. Character references can be very helpful. It is also very helpful if you do not have a previous criminal record. The older you are with no previous criminal record, the easier it is to demonstrate that you have previous good character. A history of employment and/or voluntary work can also help demonstrate previous good character.

Thirdly, the Court must decide that you should be relieved of the adverse (negative) effect/s of a conviction. There must actually be an adverse effect of the conviction, but it may be obvious to the Court. One obvious adverse effect of a conviction may be an effect on your future employment prospects. Another adverse effect can be on a visa application/s, if you are intending travelling somewhere where a visa is required and the country is likely to refuse you a visa if you have a particular conviction.

The next article will discuss the benefits and effects of being granted a spent conviction.

"Serbis LAWA's IOTs dibiayai sepenuhnya oleh Kerajaan Australia"**Hukuman yang dihilangkan I**

Ini adalah artikel pendek mengenai perkara undang-undang yang mungkin menarik untuk anda. Ini bukan nasihat undang-undang. Anda mesti selalu mendapatkan nasihat undang-undang sendiri untuk keadaan anda.

Artikel ini dan 3 artikel seterusnya akan menerangi "hukuman yang dihabiskan". Hukuman yang dihabiskan bermaksud bahawa hukuman atas kesalahan jenayah "dihabiskan", bermaksud dihapuskan, atau dihilangkan. Ini hilang untuk banyak tujuan, tetapi tidak sama.

Anda boleh ada hukuman yang dihilangkan untuk kesalahan undang-undang negara WA ("state-based offences") dan untuk kesalahan tindakan Commonwealth ("Commonwealth offences").

Untuk kesalahan berdasarkan negeri, anda boleh memohon dan diberikan hukuman yang dihilangkan:

- pada masa anda dijatuhkan hukuman atas kesalahan itu, ketika pengadilan boleh membuat perintah hukuman yang dihilangkan "SCO", atau
- setelah lebih dari 10 tahun masa penjara dari hari bulan hukuman terakhir anda, apabila pengadilan dapat mengeluarkan certificate atau membuat perintah bahawa hukuman tersebut dihilangkan (biasanya disebut "semakin tua hukuman dihabiskan").

Kami akan menerangkan kesan dari hukuman berdasarkan bagian negara dalam artikel kedua dan ketiga. Kami akan berurusan dengan semakin tua hukuman dihilangkan berdasarkan bagian negara dan mendapatkan hukuman Commonwealth yang dihilangkan di artikel keempat.

**Memohon perintah hukuman yang dihabiskan (SCO) pada saat anda dihukum karena pelanggaran berdasarkan negara**

Anda tidak boleh memohon untuk SCO semasa hukuman dijatuhkan jika anda dihukum:

- Perintah pengawasan intensif
- Tempoh penjara yang ditangguhkan bersyarat
- Tempoh penjara yang ditangguhkan
- Tempoh penjara segera.

Sekiranya anda menjalani perintah pre-sentence (perintah yang memerlukan anda, misalnya, melakukan rawatan sebelum anda dijatuhkan hukuman), anda hanya boleh memohon SCO jika kesalahan itu adalah kesalan yang ditangani oleh Mahkamah Majistret (disebut kesalahan "sederhana") dan anda telah mematuhi perintah pre-sentence.

Mahkamah tidak boleh membuat SCO, kecuali jika memutuskan:

- bahawa anda tidak mungkin melakukan kesalahan seperti ini lagi DAN
- kesalahannya itu sama ada trivial atau anda mempunyai sifat yang baik DAN
- Mahkamah menganggap bahawa anda harus dibebaskan daripada kesan buruk (negatif atau buruk) dari suatu hukuman.

SCO adalah terpilih. Walaupun anda memenuhi pemeriksaan, Mahkamah tidak boleh membuat SCO, kerana, misalnya, kesalahan itu dianggap terlalu serius.

Karakter reference anda boleh membantu permohonan SCO anda dalam beberapa cara, yang akan dibincangkan di bawah. Karakter reference harus:

- Ditujukan kepada "Majistret Yang Memimpin".
- Nyatakan bahawa penulis tau bahawa anda mengaku bersalah atas apapun kesalahan atau kesalahan tersebut.
- Katakan berapa lama penulis mengenal anda, bagaimana mereka mengenal anda, mengapa anda seorang yang berkelakuan baik, jika anda telah menyatakan penyesalan, jika mereka menganggap kesalahan itu diluar kebiasaan dan jika mereka fikir tidak mungkin anda melakukan kesalahan macam ini lagi.
- Di letak hari bulan dan ditandatangani.

Untuk menunjukkan kepada Mahkamah bahawa anda tidak mungkin melakukan kesalahan seperti ini lagi, akan berguna sekiranya orang yang buat karakter refence anda bersedia menyatakan bahawa mereka berpikir bahawa anda tidak mungkin akan melakukan kesalahan seperti ini lagi dan mengapa. Ini juga berguna sekiranya anda dapat memberitahu Mahkamah mengapa anda tidak mungkin melakukan kesalahan seperti ini lagi. Contohnya, anda mungkin telah melakukan serangan semasa mabuk, dan sekarang mendapatkan nasihat alkohol dan telah berhenti minum alkohol. Lebih susah untuk memenuhi bahagian tes ini sekiranya anda pernah melakukan kesalahan seperti ini sebelumnya.

Kedua, Mahkamah mesti menemukan bahawa kesalahan itu trivial (tidak serius sama sekali) atau bahawa anda mempunyai sifat baik sebelumnya. Beberapa kesalahan yang dianggap trivial oleh Mahkamah termasuk kesalahan melakukan tingkah laku yang tidak teratur dengan membuang air kecil dan memiliki ganja dalam jumlah yang kecil, antara lain. Banyak kesalahan yang tidak trivial dan orang bergantung kepada cuba menunjukkan kepada Mahkamah bahawa mereka mempunyai sifat baik sebelumnya.

Ada beberapa cara untuk membantu menunjukkan kepada Mahkamah bahawa anda memiliki karakter yang baik sebelumnya. Karakter reference boleh sangat membantu. Ia juga sangat membantu jika anda tidak memiliki rekod kriminal sebelumnya. Semakin tua anda tanpa rekod kriminal sebelumnya, semakin mudah untuk menunjukkan bahawa anda memiliki sifat baik sebelumnya. Sejarah pekerjaan dan/atau pekerjaan sukarela juga dapat membantu menunjukkan karakter baik sebelumnya.

Ketiga, Mahkamah harus memutuskan bahawa anda harus dibebaskan dari kesan buruk (negatif) dari suatu kesalahan. Sebenarnya harus ada kesan buruk dari kesalahan itu, tetapi mungkin jelas bagi Mahkamah. Salah satu kesan buruk dari suatu kesalahan boleh memberi kesan pada prospek pekerjaan anda di masa depan. Kesan buruk lainnya boleh berlaku pada aplikasi visa, jika anda berniat melakukan perjalanan ke suatu tempat di mana visa diperlukan dan negara tersebut kemungkinan akan menolak visa anda jika anda mempunyai kesalahan tertentu.

Artikel seterusnya akan membincangkan manfaat dan akibat dari diberikan hukuman yang dihabiskan.
