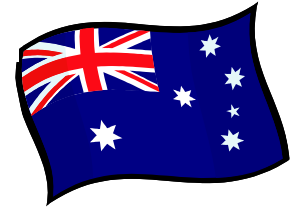

## Gambaran Cocos

This phenomena is known as a 'Fire rainbow' but it's scientific name is a circumhorizontal arc, & they are quite rare. They occur when the sun is more than 58 degrees above the horizon. The hexagonal ice crystals in the cirrus cloud must be shaped like thick plates & the faces of each crystal are parallel to the ground. When the sunlight passes through these ice crystals - & they are aligned just right - it refracts (or bends) & lights up that section of cloud in a spectrum of colours.

## Drug offences and you VII – importing/exporting illegal drugs/plants

These are short articles about legal issues that may interest you. They are not legal advice. You should always get individual legal advice for your situation.

This is the seventh article about drug offences under state-based legislation that is applied to Christmas and Cocos (Keeling) Islands and under Commonwealth legislation.

This is the third about Commonwealth drug offences – that is, offences under Commonwealth legislation. The *Criminal Code Act 1995 (Cth)* (we will call it the *Criminal Code (Cth)*) and the *Criminal Code Regulations 2002 (Cth)* (we will call them the *Regulations*) deal with Commonwealth drug offences.

This article is about importing/exporting “border controlled drugs” or “border controlled plants” or “border controlled precursors”. It includes bringing these things into and taking them out of Australia. A precursor is a substance necessary for the manufacture of the illegal drug.

### Some definitions

The *Criminal Code (Cth)* defines a “border controlled drug” as one listed as such by a regulation, or an analogue (which means another similar form) of the drug or one that is urgently determined by the Minister to be a border controlled drug. A schedule in the *Regulations* lists them.

Examples include cocaine, amphetamine, heroin, cannabis and ketamine, among many others.

A “border controlled plant” is one listed as such by a regulation, or one that is urgently determined by the Minister to be a border controlled plant. A schedule in the *Regulations* lists them. Examples include cannabis and some poppies.

A “border controlled precursor” is one listed as such by a regulation, or certain chemical relatives of precursors, or one urgently determined by the Minister to be one. Examples include lysergic acid (a precursor for LSD) and ephedrine (a precursor for amphetamine).

In general terms, you can be charged with importing or exporting the border controlled drug or plant or precursor (the least serious charge), or importing/exporting a “marketable” quantity of it (a more serious charge) or importing/exporting a “commercial” quantity of it (the most serious charge).

The schedules that list border controlled drugs, precursors and plants also set out the amounts that constitute marketable and commercial quantities of each drug and precursor and the numbers (or weight) of plants that constitute marketable and commercial quantities of plants. Not all plants have marketable and commercial quantities.

A “marketable” quantity is usually measured in grams, for drugs or precursors. Some examples are if you have 250 grams or more of amphetamine, cocaine or heroin or 500 or more grams of ketamine for drugs or 3.2 or more grams of ephedrine as a precursor. One hundred or more cannabis plants is a marketable number of plants, or having 25 kgs or more of cannabis plant material.

A “commercial” quantity is usually measured in kilograms, for drugs or precursors. Some examples are if you have 1.5 kgs or more of heroin, or 0.75 kgs or more of amphetamine for drugs or 1.2 kgs of ephedrine, as a precursor. One thousand or more cannabis plants is a commercial number of plants, or having 250 kgs or more of cannabis plant material.

### Importing/exporting border controlled drugs or plants

If you import/export a border controlled drug or plant you commit an offence. The maximum penalty is 10 years imprisonment or 2,000 penalty units (a penalty unit (PU) is currently \$210) or both. This offence can be dealt with by a Magistrates Court if both the accused person and the prosecution agree.

If the amount is a marketable quantity of border controlled drug or plants the maximum penalty is 25 years imprisonment or 5,000 PUs or both. This offence is indictable only. This means that it can only be dealt with by the District Court and not by the Magistrates Court.

If the amount is a commercial quantity of border controlled drugs or plants the maximum penalty is imprisonment for life or 7,500 PUs or both. This offence is indictable only and can only be dealt with by the Supreme Court, and not by the District Court, because the maximum penalty is life imprisonment.

### Importing/exporting border controlled precursors

You commit an offence if you import/export:

- a border controlled precursor
- intending to manufacture a controlled drug and/or believing that someone else intends to use the precursor to manufacture a controlled drug

The maximum penalty is imprisonment for 7 years or 1,400 PUs or both. This offence can be dealt with by a Magistrates Court if both the accused person and the prosecution agree.

If the amount is a marketable quantity the maximum penalty is imprisonment for 15 years or 3,000 PUs or both. If the amount is a commercial quantity the maximum penalty is imprisonment for 25 years or 5,000 PUs or both. Both of these offences are indictable only.

With all of the offences mentioned in this article, you can also be found guilty of the offence if you are reckless as to whether it is a border controlled drug, border controlled plant or border controlled precursor, or not.

The next article will deal with the Commonwealth offences of trafficking illegal drugs.

**Pelanggaran drug dan kamu VII – mengimport/mengexport drug/tumbuhan yang dilarang**

Ini adalah majalah-majalah pendek tentang perkara-perkara legal yang mungkin kamu berminat. Ia bukan nasihat legal. Kamu mesti selalu mengambil nasihat legal tersendiri untuk keadaan kamu.

Ini majalah yang ke tuju tentang pelanggaran drug menurut perundangan berdasarkan state yang digunakan di Pulu Christmas dan Cocos (Keeling) dan dibawa perundangan Commonwealth.

Ini majalah yang ketiga tentang pelanggaran drug menurut Commonwealth – iaitu, pelanggaran dibawa undang-undang Commonwealth. Criminal Code Act 1995 (Cth) (kita akan memanggil Criminal Code (Cth) dan Criminal Code Regulations 2002 (Cth) (kita akan memanggil Regulations) berurusan dengan pelanggaran drug menurut Commonwealth.

Majalah ini tentang importing/exporting "drug yang dijaga dalam tempatan" atau "tumbuhan yang dijaga dalam tempatan" atau "pendahuluan drug yang dijaga dalam tempatan". Ia termasuk membawa benda-benda ini ke dalam dan membawa keluar Australia. Sebuah 'pendahuluan' adalah bahan yang diperlukan untuk pembuatan drug terlarang.

**Berberapa keterangan**

Criminal Code (Cth) menerangkan "drug yang dijaga dalam tempatan" sebagai salahsatu yang didaftarkan oleh sebuah undang-undang, atau sesuatu yang sama, atau drug yang dengan segera dinyatakan oleh Minister untuk menjadi drug yang dijaga dalam tempatan. Daftaran dalam Perundangan menerangkannya. Contohnya termasuk cocaine, amphetamine, heroin, cannabis dan ketamine, diantaranya.

Sebuah "tumbuhan yang dijaga dalam tempatan" adalah salahsatu yang didaftar oleh undang-undang, atau satu yang dinyatakan oleh Minister untuk menjadi tumbuhan yang dijaga oleh tempatan. Daftaran dalam Perundangan menerangkan semuanya. Contohnya termasuk cannabis dan beberapa poppies.

Sebuah "bahan pendahulu yang dijaga dalam tempatan" adalah salahsatu yang didaftar oleh undang-undang, atau sesuatu sahabat chemical, atau satu yang dinyatakan oleh Minister dengan segera. Contohnya termasuk lysergic acid (pendahulu untuk LSD) dan ephedrine (sebuah bahan pendahulu untuk amphetamine).

Secara umumnya, kamu boleh didakwa dengan mengimport atau mengexport drug atau tumbuhan atau bahan pendahulu yang dijaga dalam tempatan (dakwaan yang kurang berat), atau mengimport/mengexport jumlah "jualan" (dakwaan yang lebih berat) atau mengimport/export jumlah "jualan commercial" (dakwaan yang paling berat).

Daftaran yang menerangkan drugs, bahan pendahulu dan tumbuhan yang dijaga dalam tempatan juga menerangkan jumlah yang merupakan jumlah "jualan" dan jumlah "jualan commercial" untuk setiap drug dan bahan pendahulu dan berapa (atau beratnya) tumbuhan yang merupakan jumlah "jualan" dan jumlah "jualan commercial" tumbuhan itu. Tidak semua tumbuhan mempunyai jumlah "jualan" dan "jualan commercial".

Jumlah "jualan" biasanya diukur dalam grams, untuk drug dan bahan pendahulu. Berberapa contoh ialah kalau kamu mempunyai 250 gram atau lebih amphetamine, cocaine atau heroin atau 500 atau lebih gram ketamin untuk drugs atau 3.2 gram atau lebih ephedrine sebagai bahan pendahulu. Satu ratus atau lebih tumbuhan cannabis dalam jumlah yang boleh menjadi jualan, atau mempunyai 25 kgs atau lebih bahan tumbuhan cannabis.

Jumlah "jualan commercial" biasanya dikira dalam kilograms, untuk drug atau bahan pendahulu. Berberapa contoh ialah kalau kamu ada 1.5 kg atau lebih heroin, atau 0.75 kg atau lebih amphetamine untuk drug atau 1.2 kgs ephedrine, sebagai bahan pendahulu. Satu ribu atau lebih tumbuhan cannabis adalah jumlah tumbuhan commercial, atau mempunyai 250 kgs atau lebih bahan tumbuhan cannabis.

**Mengimport/Mengexport drug atau tumbuhan**

Kalau kamu import/export drug atau tumbuhan yang dijaga dalam tempatan kamu telah membuat pelanggaran. Hukuman maksimum ialah 10 tahun dipenjarakan atau 2,000 unit hukuman (satu unit hukuman (PU) ialah \$210 pada masa sekarang) atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh diurus dengan Magistrates Court kalau kedua-dua orang yang dituduh dan pendakwanya bersetuju.

Kalau jumlah drug atau tumbuhan yang dijaga ditempatkan sehingga jumlah "jualan" banyaknya, hukuman maksimum ialah 25 tahun dipenjarakan atau 5,000 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh didakwa sahaja. Ini bermaksud yang ia hanya boleh diurus melalui District Court dan bukan oleh Magistrates Court.

Kalau jumlah drug atau tumbuhan yang dijaga ditempatkan sehingga jumlah "jualan commercial", hukuman maksimum ialah dipenjarakan seumur hidup atau 7,500 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh didakwa sahaja dan hanya boleh diurus oleh Supreme Court, dan tidak oleh District Court, bersebabkan hukuman maksimum ialah dipenjarakan seumur hidup.

**Mengimport/Mengexport bahan pendahulu yang dijaga dalam tempatan**

Kamu membuat pelanggaran kalau kamu import/export:

bahan pendahulu yang dijaga ditempatkan

bertujuan untuk membuat drug yang dijaga dan/atau mempercayai seorang yang bertujuan untuk menggunakan bahan pendahuluan untuk membuat drug yang dijaga.

Hukuman maksimum ialah 7 tahun dipenjarakan atau 1,400 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Pelanggaran ini boleh diurus di Magistrates Court kalau kedua-dua orang yang dituduh dan pendakwanya bersetuju.

Kalau jumlahnya jumlah penjualan, hukuman maksimum ialah penjara untuk 15 tahun atau 3,000 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Kalau jumlahnya jumlah jualan commercial, hukuman maksimum ialah dipenjarakan untuk 25 tahun atau 5,000 PUs atau kedua-duanya. Kedua-dua pelanggaran ini adalah pendakwaan sahaja.

Dengan semua pelanggaran tersebut dalam majalah ini, kamu juga boleh didapati bersalah kalau kamu ceroboh tidak kira drug yang dijaga ditempatkan, tumbuhan yang dijaga ditempatkan ataupun bahan pendahulu yang dijaga ditempatkan, atau tidak.

Majalah seterusnya akan membincangkan tentang pelanggaran berdasarkan Commonwealth mengenai pelanggaran perdagangan drug terlarang.
